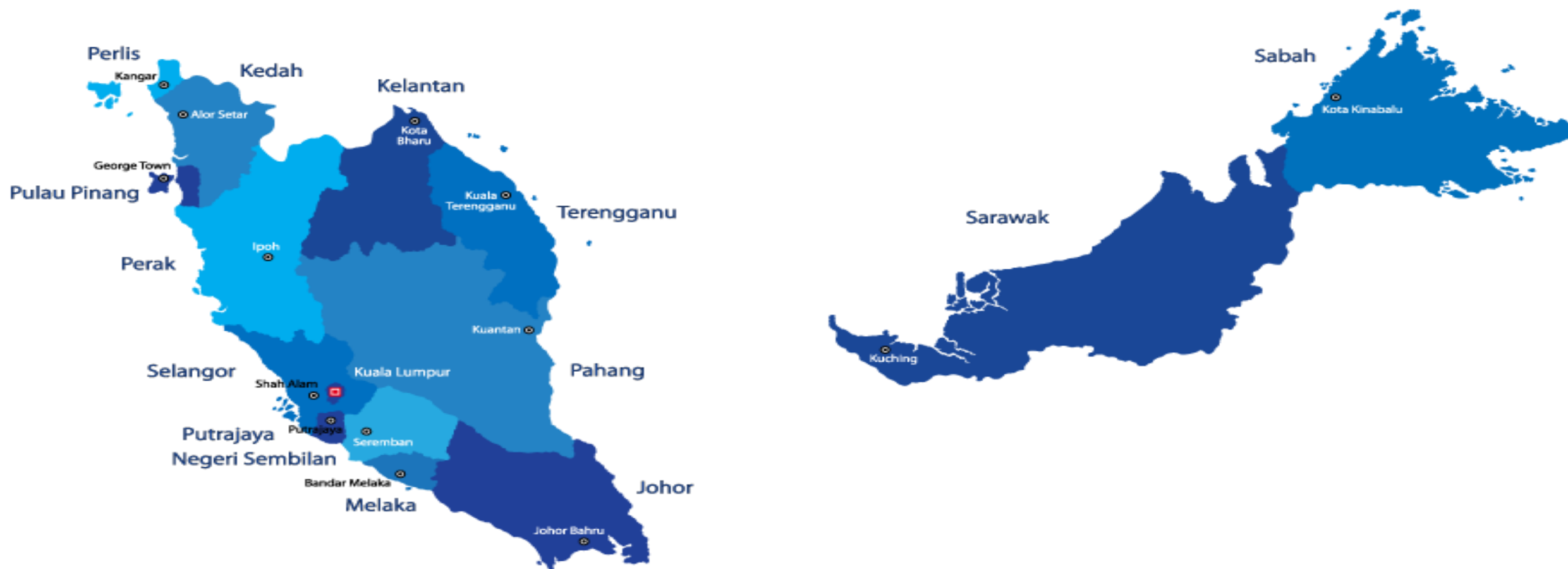

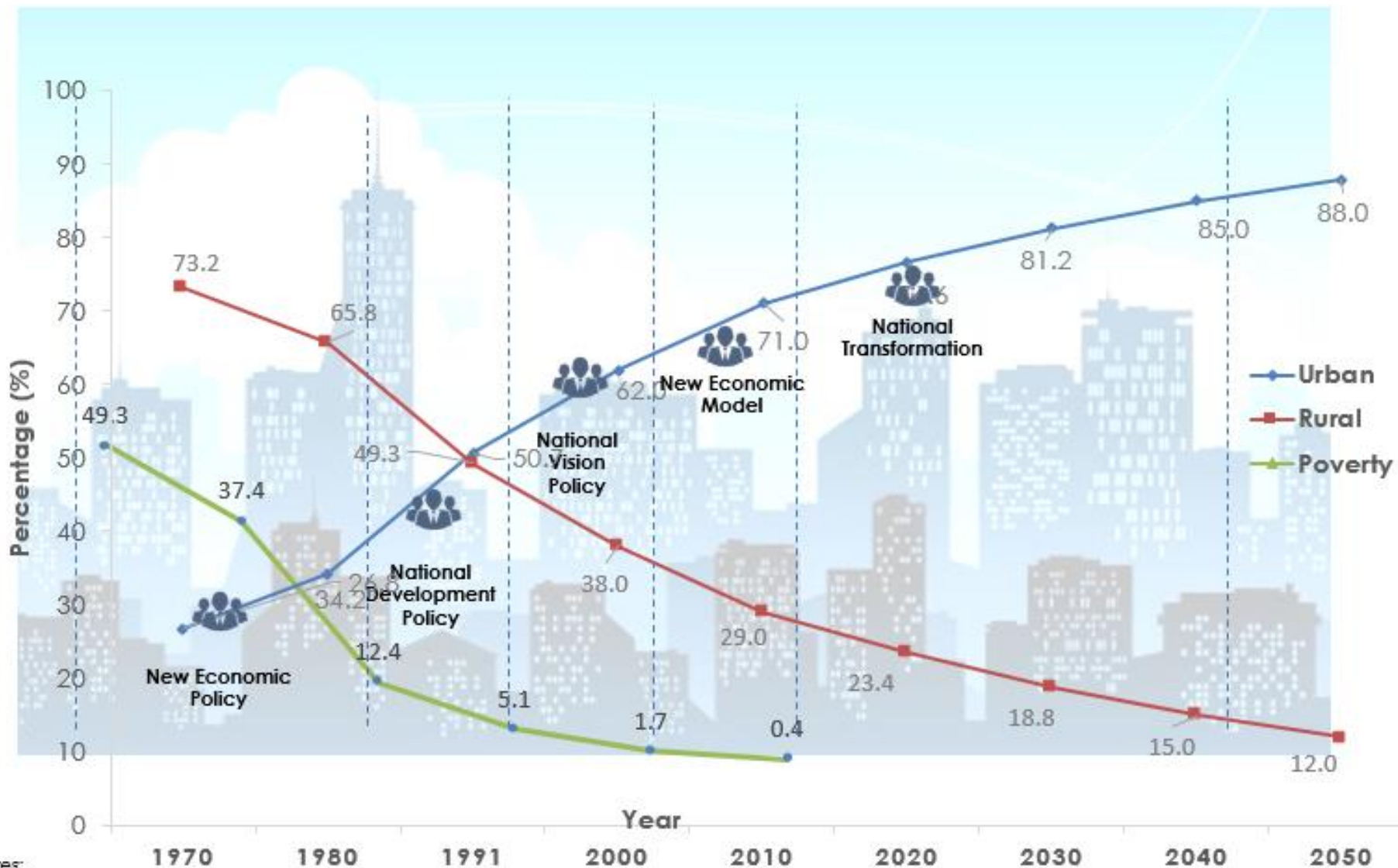

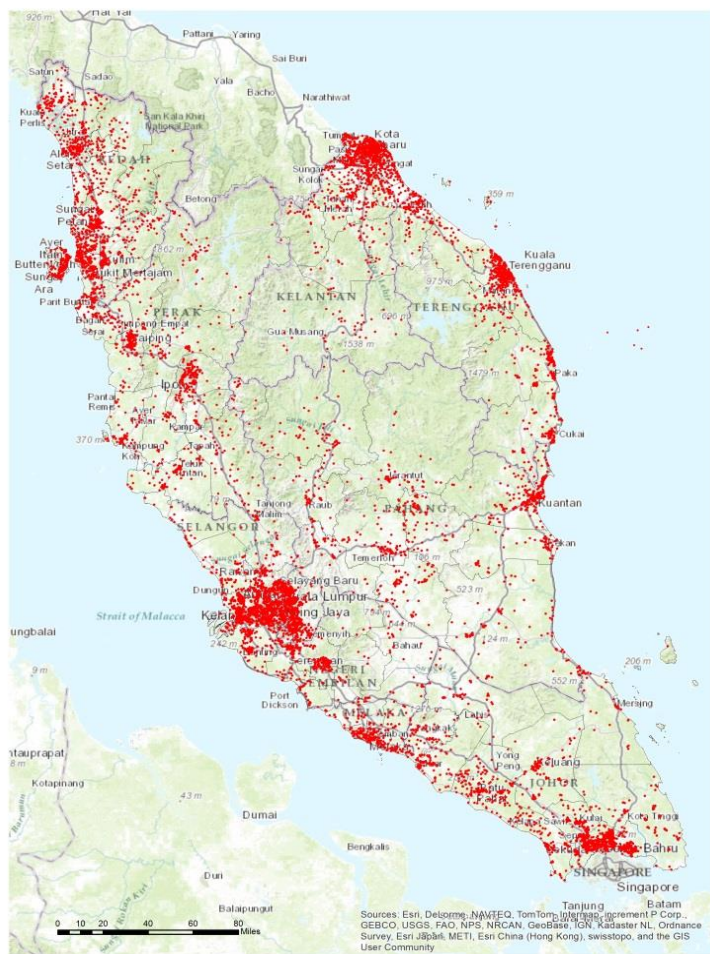


# Urban Transition in Malaysia, 1970-2050

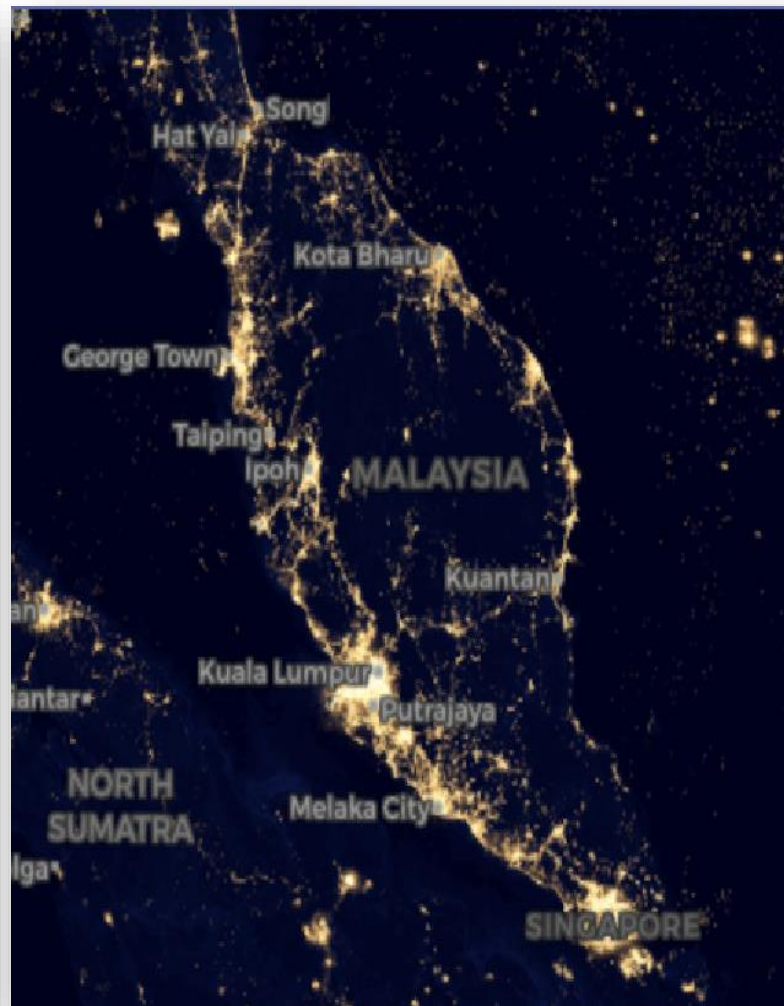

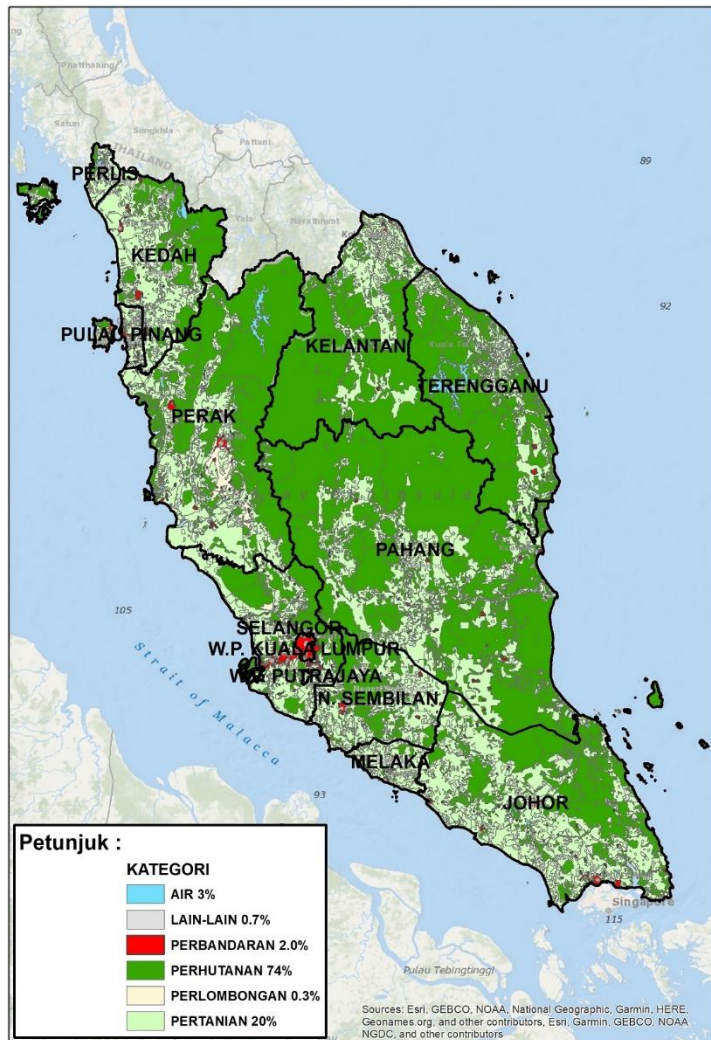

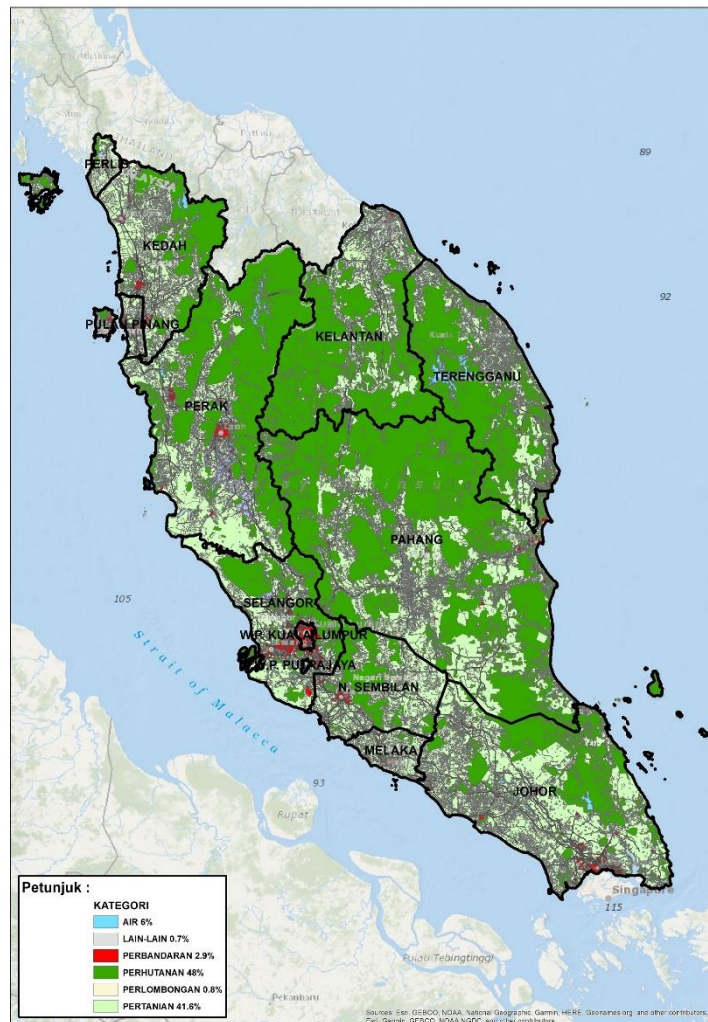
# Land use Classification

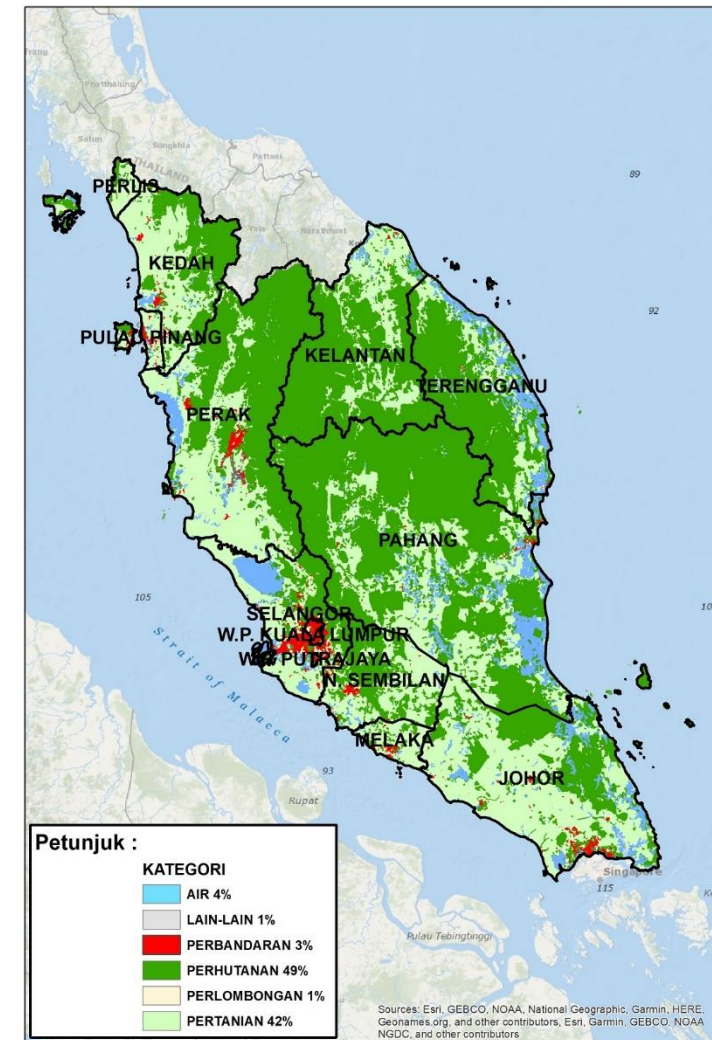

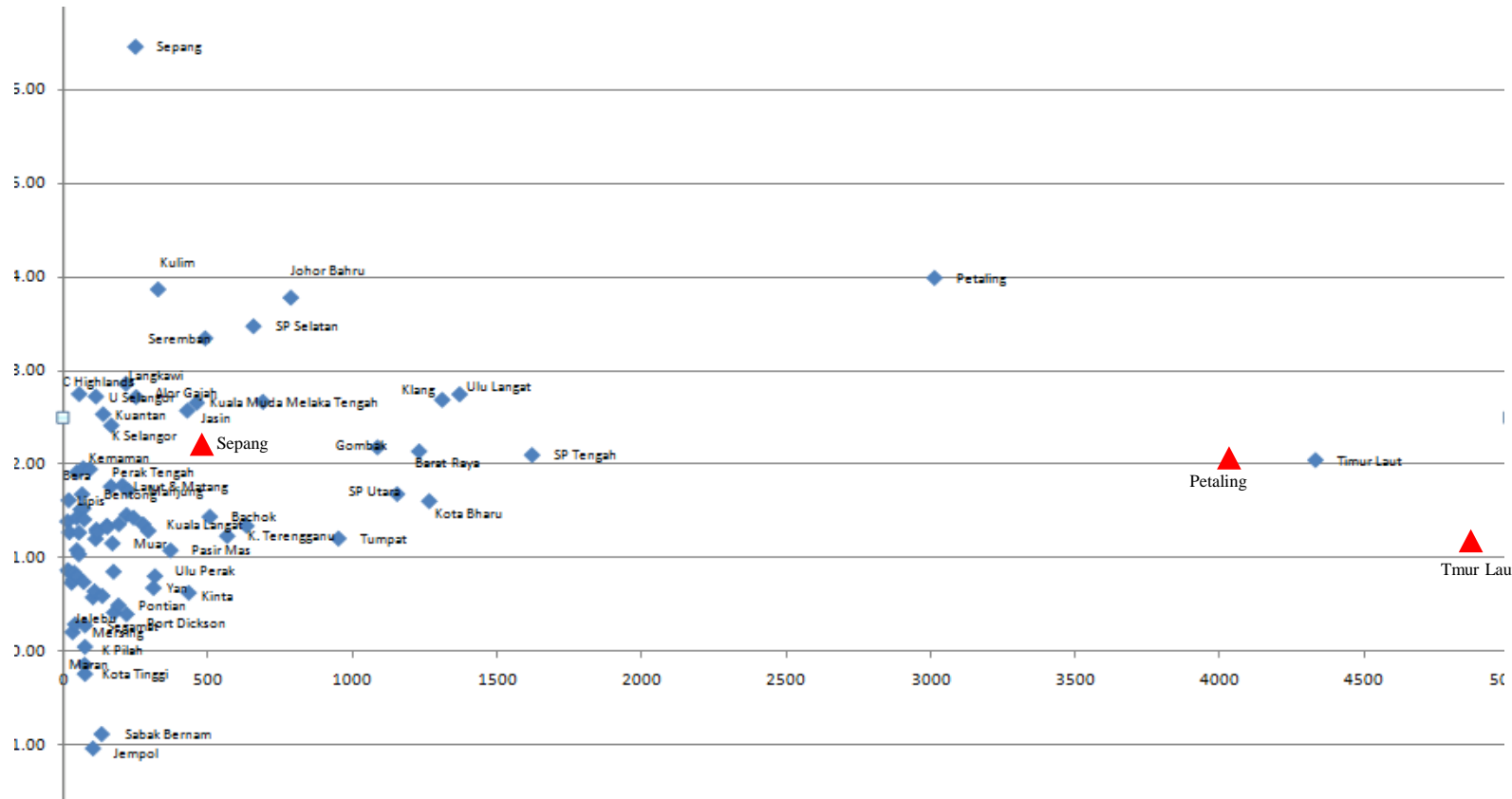

# Population growth and density



More than a third (34.4%) of the national population lives in the **ten most populous** districts:

Petaling, Kuala Lumpur, Johor Bahru, Ulu Langat, Klang, Kinta, Gombak, Kuching, Seremban, and Timur Laut

Sepang recorded the highest growth (2000-2010) while Timur Laut remain the most densely district in Malaysia.

Population density and rate population growth rate, by district 2000-2010 ◆ and 2010-2020 ▲

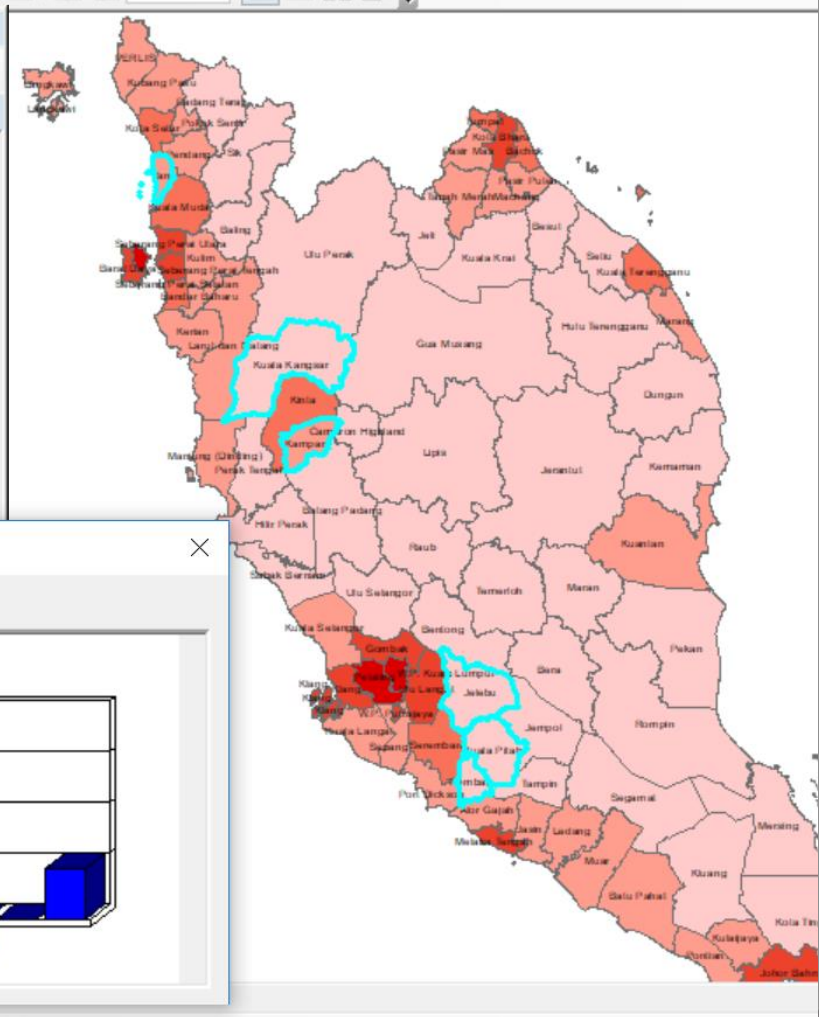

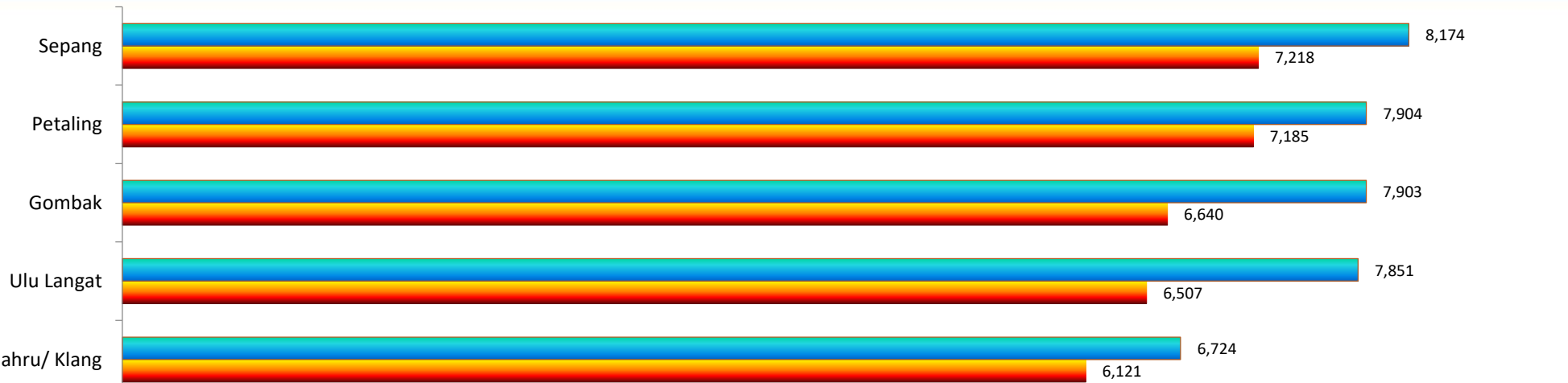

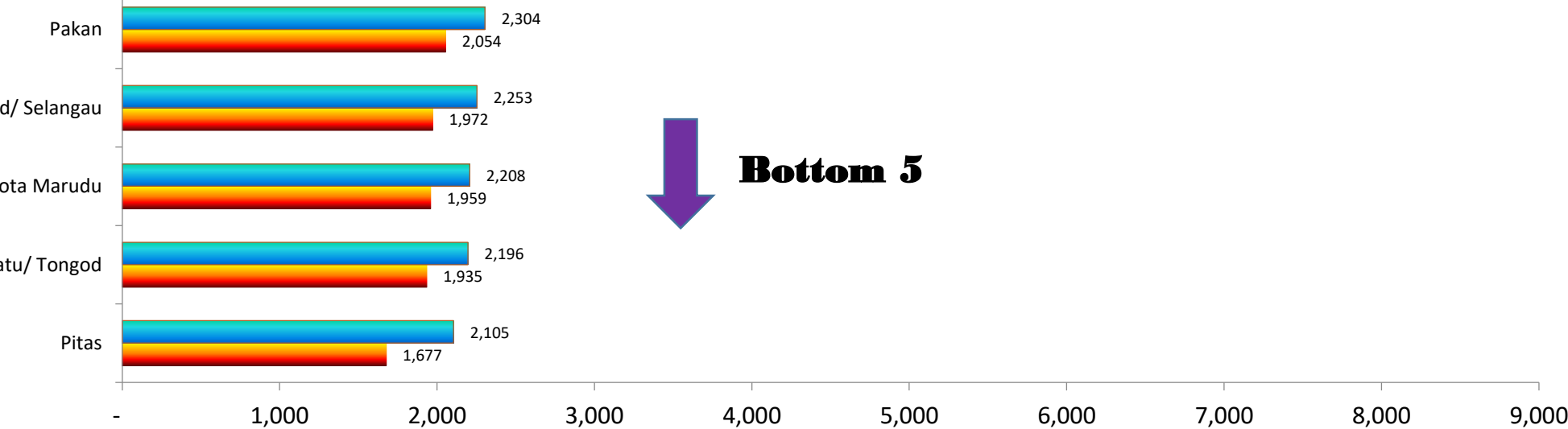
# Median Income, District 2014 & 2016
