**INDEKS HARGA PENGELUAR PERKHIDMATAN, MALAYSIA
SUKU TAHUN KEEMPAT 2025**

Indeks Harga Pengeluar Perkhidmatan Malaysia meningkat 1.0 peratus pada suku tahun keempat 2025, kadar yang sama seperti suku tahun sebelumnya

PUTRAJAYA, 5 FEBRUARI 2026 – Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) telah menerbitkan **Indeks Harga Pengeluar Perkhidmatan (IHPRP), Suku Tahun Keempat 2025**, yang memberikan ukuran perubahan harga pengeluar dalam sektor perkhidmatan tempatan di Malaysia. IHPRP meningkat 1.0 peratus pada suku tahun keempat 2025, mengekalkan kadar yang sama bagi tiga suku tahun berturut-turut.

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin menjelaskan dalam kenyataannya, “Indeks Penginapan dan aktiviti perkhidmatan makanan & minuman meningkat 3.1 peratus berbanding peningkatan 3.4 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini disumbangkan oleh indeks Restoran dan aktiviti perkhidmatan makanan bergerak (3.5%) dan Aktiviti perkhidmatan minuman (3.0%). Sementara itu, indeks Pengangkutan meningkat 2.2 peratus berbanding kenaikan 0.5 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya, didorong terutamanya oleh indeks Pengangkutan penumpang udara yang mencatatkan peningkatan 7.1 peratus. Indeks Pendidikan juga meningkat 1.5 peratus (ST3 2025: 1.4%), didorong oleh Pendidikan menengah (2.3%) dan Pendidikan tinggi (1.6%). Indeks lain yang mencatatkan peningkatan ialah Kesihatan (0.7%), Aktiviti hartanah (0.6%) dan Profesional (0.5%).”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin turut menambah, “Sebaliknya, indeks Kesenian, hiburan & rekreasi mencatatkan penurunan 3.8 peratus, selepas peningkatan perlahan 0.4 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya. Indeks Maklumat & komunikasi juga mencatatkan penurunan sebanyak 0.1 peratus.”

Ketua Perangkawan Malaysia mengulas lanjut, “Pada asas suku tahunan, IHPRP meningkat 0.3 peratus, berbanding 0.1 peratus pada suku tahun sebelumnya. Peningkatan ini terutamanya disumbangkan oleh indeks Pengangkutan (1.2%) dan Penginapan dan aktiviti perkhidmatan makanan & minuman (0.8%). Selain itu, indeks Aktiviti hartanah, Pendidikan dan Kesihatan masing-masing mencatatkan peningkatan

0.2 peratus, manakala indeks Profesional meningkat 0.1 peratus, sama seperti pada suku tahun sebelumnya. Walau bagaimanapun, indeks Kesenian, hiburan & rekreasi menurun sebanyak 3.3 peratus, manakala indeks Maklumat & komunikasi kekal tidak berubah.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin juga merumuskan bahawa IHPRP mencatatkan peningkatan marginal 0.9 peratus pada 2025, berbanding kenaikan 0.7 peratus pada 2024. Peningkatan ini terutamanya didorong oleh indeks Penginapan dan aktiviti perkhidmatan makanan & minuman (3.4%), diikuti oleh indeks Kesenian, hiburan & rekreasi (1.8%) dan Pendidikan (1.3%). Indeks lain yang mencatatkan peningkatan termasuklah Kesihatan (0.7%), Profesional (0.6%) dan Aktiviti hartanah (0.2%). Sebaliknya, indeks Pengangkutan menurun 0.4 peratus dan indeks Maklumat & komunikasi juga mencatatkan penurunan perlahan 0.1 peratus.

Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) sedang melaksanakan Banci Ekonomi 2026 (BE2026), bertemakan “Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat”. Pelaksanaan Banci Ekonomi kali keenam ini berlangsung dari 5 Januari hingga 31 Oktober 2026. BE2026 bertujuan untuk mengumpul data yang menyeluruh dan berstruktur daripada semua pertubuhan perniagaan berdaftar dan tidak berdaftar di Malaysia, bagi menilai prestasi, struktur serta ciri-ciri ekonomi negara secara komprehensif dan berasaskan bukti.





**SERVICES PRODUCER PRICE INDEX, MALAYSIA
FOURTH QUARTER 2025**

Malaysia's Services Producer Price Index up 1.0 per cent in fourth quarter of 2025, same rate as previous quarter

PUTRAJAYA, FEBRUARY 5th, 2026 – The Department of Statistics, Malaysia today released a report of the **Services Producer Price Index (SPPI), Fourth Quarter 2025**, which providing a measures of producer prices changes within Malaysia's domestic services sector. The SPPI rose by 1.0 per cent in the fourth quarter of 2025, maintaining the same rate for the third consecutive quarter.

In a statement, Chief Statistician Malaysia, Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin, stated, "The Accommodation and food & beverage service activities index increased by 3.1 per cent, compared to 3.4 per cent increase in the previous quarter. This was driven by the Restaurants and mobile food service activities index (3.5%) and Beverage service activities (3.0%). Meanwhile, the Transportation index rose by 2.2 per cent, up from a 0.5 per cent increase in the previous quarter, mainly driven by the Passenger air transport index, which recorded an increase of 7.1 per cent. The Education index also rose by 1.5 per cent (Q3 2025: 1.4%), driven by Secondary education (2.3%) and Higher education (1.6%). Other indices that recorded an increase were Health (0.7%), Real estate activities (0.6%) and Professional (0.5%)."

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also added that, "In contrast, the Arts, entertainment & recreation index declined by 3.8 per cent, after a slight increase of 0.4 per cent in the previous quarter. The Information & communication index also recorded a slight decrease by 0.1 per cent."

The Chief Statistician Malaysia further elaborated that, "On a quarter-on-quarter basis, the SPPI increased by 0.3 per cent, compared to 0.1 per cent in the previous quarter. This increase was mainly contributed by Transportation (1.2%) and Accommodation and food & beverage service activities (0.8%) indices. Additionally, the Real estate activities, Education, and Health indices each recorded an increase of 0.2 per cent, while the Professional index increased by 0.1 per cent, similar to the previous quarter.

However, the Arts, entertainment & recreation index declined by 3.3 per cent, while the Information & communication index remained unchanged.”

Dato' Sri Dr. Mohd Uzir Mahidin also summarised that the SPPI recorded a marginal increase of 0.9 per cent in 2025, compared to a 0.7 per cent rise in 2024. The increase was primarily driven by the Accommodation and food & beverage service activities (3.4%), followed by Arts, entertainment & recreation index (1.8%), and Education (1.3%) indices. Other indices that recorded an increase were Health (0.7%), Professional (0.6%) and Real estate activities (0.2%). In contrast, the Transportation index declined by 0.4 per cent and Information & communication index recorded a slight decrease of 0.1 per cent.

The Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is conducting the Economic Census 2026 (BE2026), themed “Data Nadi Ekonomi Rakyat”. The sixth Economic Census, running from 5th January to 31st October 2026. BE2026 aims to collect comprehensive, structured data from all registered and unregistered business establishments in Malaysia to assess the nation’s economic performance, structure and characteristics in an evidence-based manner.

Malaysia has, for the first time, successfully secured the top position globally in the biennial Open Data Inventory (ODIN) 2024/25 report released by Open Data Watch (ODW), surpassing 197 other countries. This achievement marks a significant leap from its 67th position in the ODIN 2022/23 assessment.

Chart 1: Quarterly Services Producer Price Index, Q1 2022 – Q4 2025





Chart 2: Annual Services Producer Price Index, 2011 – 2025
