Laporan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan diterbitkan oleh Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) menggunakan sumber data pentadbiran yang diperoleh daripada agensi berkaitan seperti Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) dan Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO). Inisiatif menerbitkan Laporan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan ini adalah bagi memenuhi permintaan yang semakin meningkat bagi statistik upah yang komprehensif dengan kekerapan yang tinggi. Laporan ini menyediakan statistik upah pekerja warganegara Malaysia mengikut ciri-ciri demografi dan sosioekonomi antaranya jantina, etnik, kumpulan umur, aktiviti ekonomi dan negeri.

The Quarterly Employee Wages Statistics (Formal Sector) Report is published by the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) using administrative data sources obtained from relevant agencies such as the Employees Provident Fund (EPF) and the Social Security Organization (SOCSO). The initiative to publish this Quarterly Employee Wages Statistics (Formal Sector) Report is to meet the escalating demand for comprehensive wage statistics with high frequency. This report provides wage statistics for Malaysian citizens according to demographic and socioeconomic characteristics encompassing sex, ethnic, age groups, economic activities and state.

Employee wages statistics serves as a crucial source of information which were used as input for labour market analysis, policy formulation as well as planning, implementing and monitoring programmes related to human resource development towards strengthening the national labour market. These statistics also serve as a vital reference for researchers, economists, academicians, private sector and individuals in research related to employment, wages and the labour market.

This publication contains three parts. The first part presents a summary of findings of the number of formal sector employees, median wage and wage distribution. In the second part, a series of statistics tables are presented. Technical aspects such as the method of data collection, scope & coverage and concept & definitions are provided in the final part to facilitate users' understanding of the published statistics.

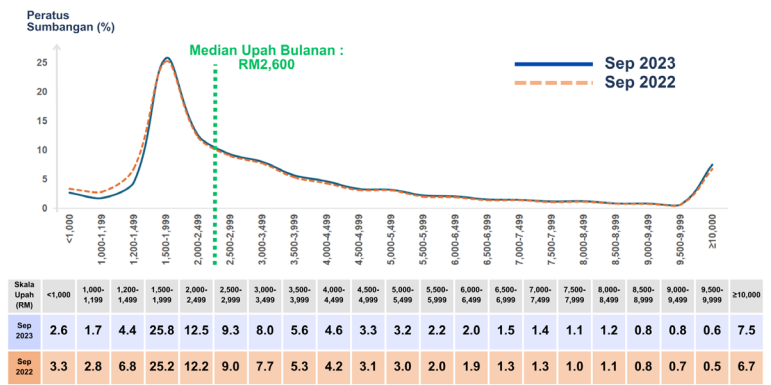
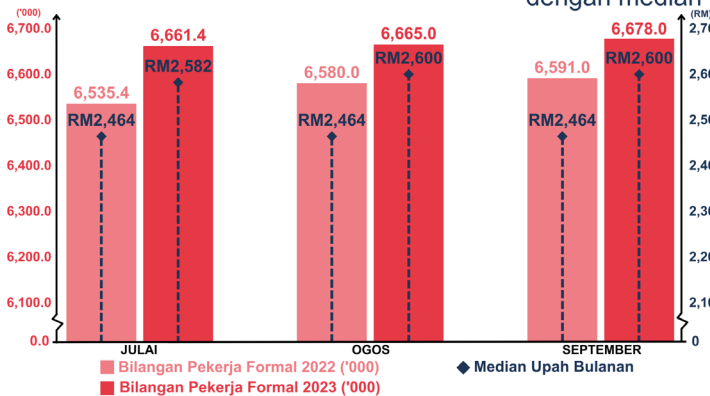

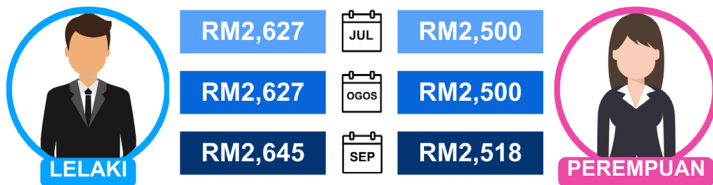
Bilangan pekerja formal warganegara pada **September 2023** adalah seramai **6,678.0** ribu orang dengan median upah bulanan **RM2,600**.

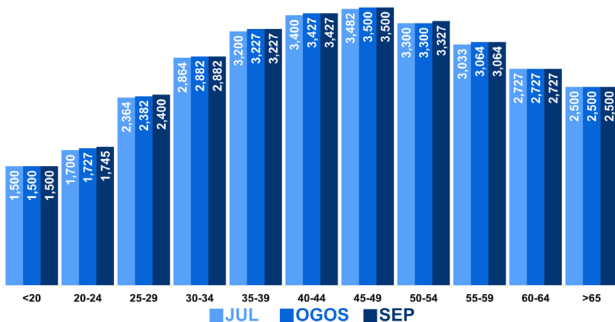

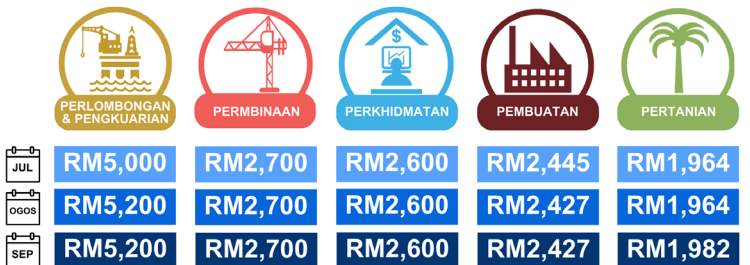

Median Upah Bulanan (RM)



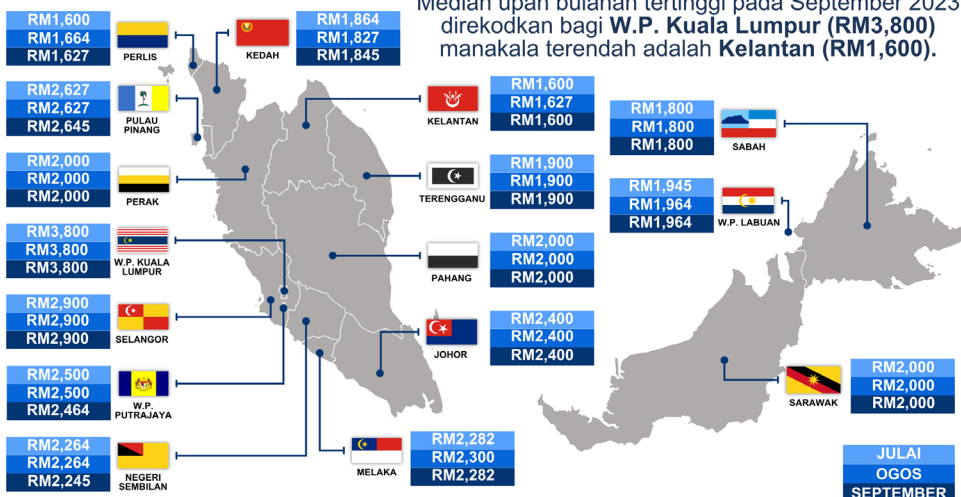
AKTIVITI EKONOMI

KONSEP & DEFINISI

Upah meliputi semua ganjaran kepada pekerja dalam bentuk wang termasuk bonus, komisen dan elaun dalam tempoh rujukan.

Median merujuk kepada nilai yang terletak di tengah-tengah susunan suatu set nombor yang disusun mengikut tertib. Median upah digunakan untuk memberi gambaran "purata upah" yang lebih tepat kerana tidak terkesan kepada nilai ekstrem.

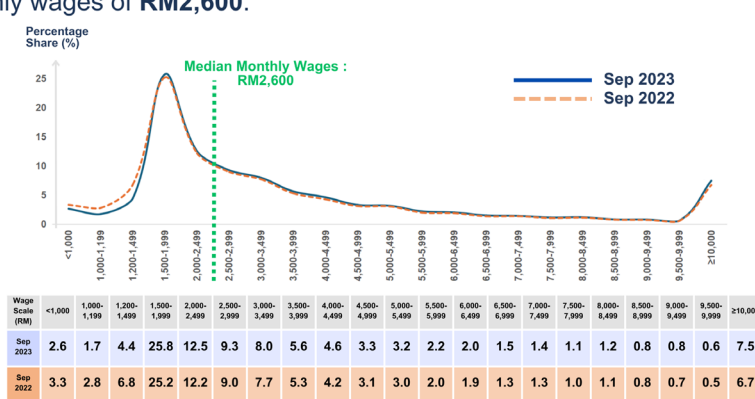
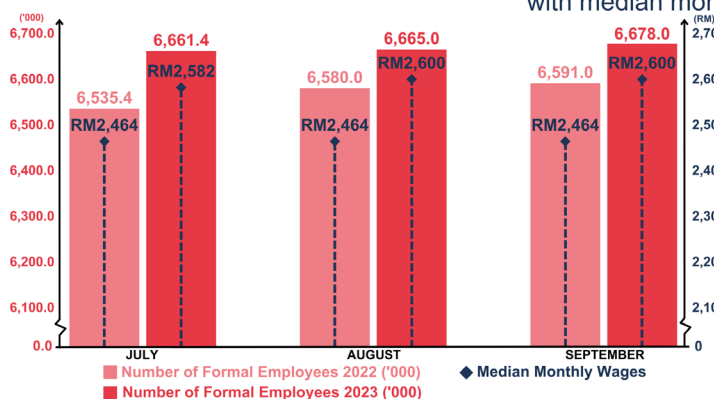

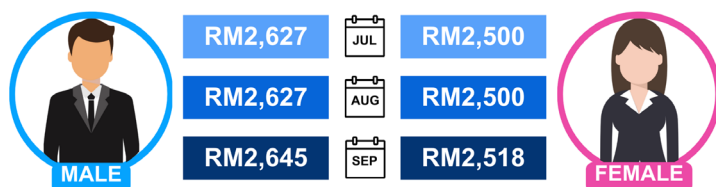
The number of citizen formal employees in September 2023 was **6,678.0 thousand persons** with median monthly wages of **RM2,600**.

BY ETHNIC

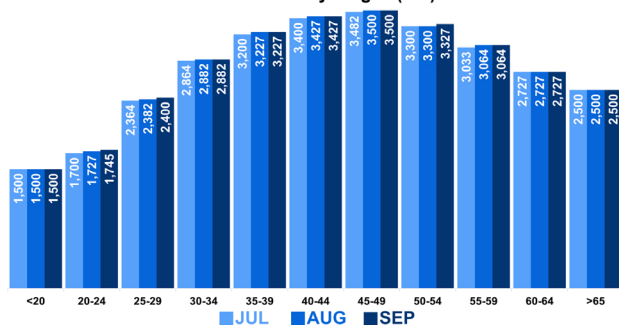
Chinese formal employees recorded the highest median monthly wages in September 2023 (**RM4,000**).



BY AGE GROUP

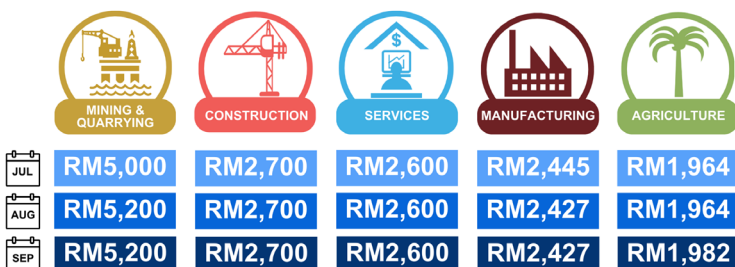
The age group of **45 to 49 years** posted the highest median monthly wages of **RM3,500** in September 2023.

Median Monthly Wages (RM)



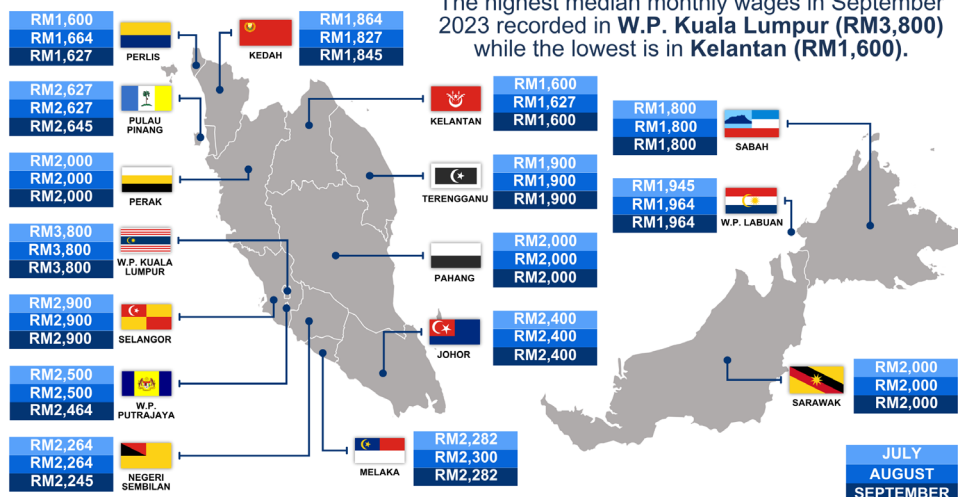
BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

The highest median monthly wages in September 2023 was recorded in **Mining & quarrying sector (RM5,200)**, followed by Construction, Services, Manufacturing and Agriculture.



BY STATES

The highest median monthly wages in September 2023 recorded in **W.P. Kuala Lumpur (RM3,800)** while the lowest is in **Kelantan (RM1,600)**.



CONCEPT & DEFINITION

Wages refer to all remuneration paid to employees, including bonuses, commissions and allowances, during the reference period.

The **Median** refers to the middle observation in a set of data arranged in a sequence. The median wage is used to give a more accurate picture of the "average wage", as the determination of the median is not affected by extreme values.

SCOPE & COVERAGE

These statistics is based on the administrative data, including data on the mandatory contribution of retirement savings by the private and non-pensionable public sectors and data on the contribution of social security insurance from various agencies. The data focus only on the citizen formal employees and does not cover employed persons fall under non-standard employment, including own-account workers and unpaid family workers.

RINGKASAN PENEMUAN

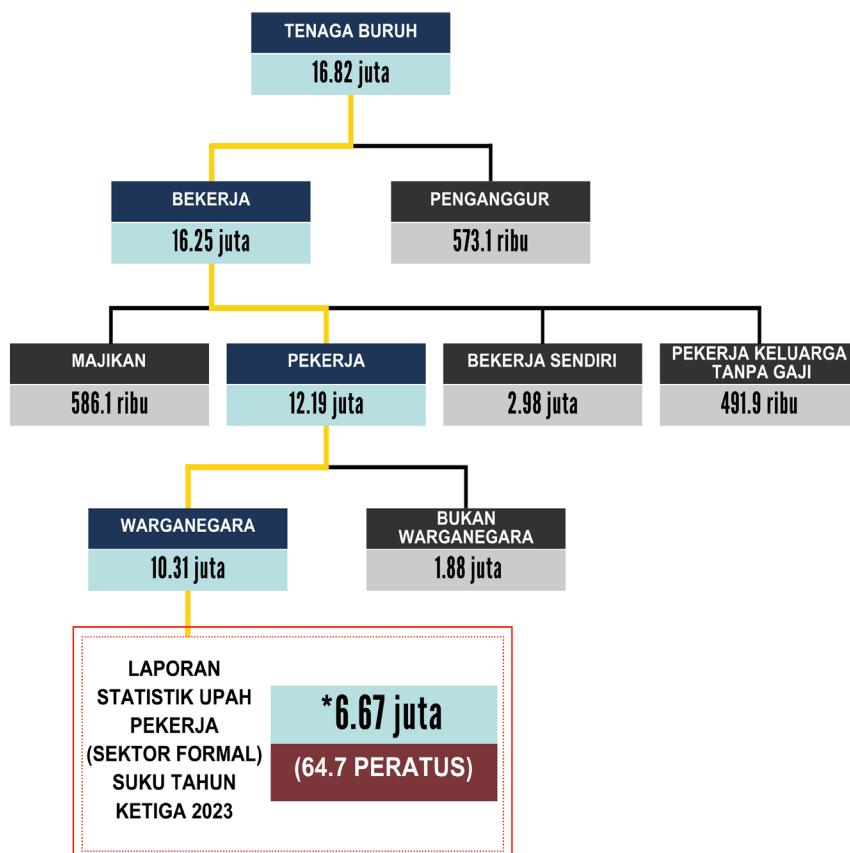
1. PENGENALAN

Penerbitan Statistik Upah Pekerja (Sektor Formal) Suku Tahunan adalah sebahagian daripada inisiatif Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia untuk menyediakan statistik upah yang lebih komprehensif, terperinci dan bertepatan masa bagi memenuhi permintaan pengguna yang semakin meningkat. Laporan ini adalah berdasarkan data pentadbiran dari pelbagai agensi dan memberi tumpuan kepada pekerja warganegara dalam sektor formal swasta Malaysia. Upah yang dianggarkan dalam penerbitan ini merujuk kepada semua ganjaran kewangan meliputi bonus, komisen, dan elaun yang dibayar kepada pekerja untuk pekerjaan mereka dalam tempoh rujukan. Statistik yang dikeluarkan ini boleh digunakan sebagai input untuk menganalisis kedudukan pasaran buruh, menggubal dasar serta merancang, melaksana dan memantau program berkaitan Pembangunan sumber manusia ke arah pengukuhan pasaran buruh negara.

2. KEDUDUKAN UPAH PEKERJA FORMAL MALAYSIA

Pasaran buruh Malaysia menunjukkan prospek yang memberangsangkan pada suku tahun ketiga 2023 walaupun disebalik ketidaktentuan ekonomi global. Menurut Laporan Survei Tenaga Buruh pada suku tahun ketiga 2023, terdapat 16.25 juta orang yang bekerja berbanding suku tahun yang sebelumnya (Q2 2023: 16.15 juta orang) yang terdiri daripada pekerja bergaji di sektor awam dan swasta, majikan, bekerja sendiri, dan pekerja keluarga tanpa gaji. Paparan 1: Kerangka Analisis Gaji & Upah Bulanan, ST3 2023



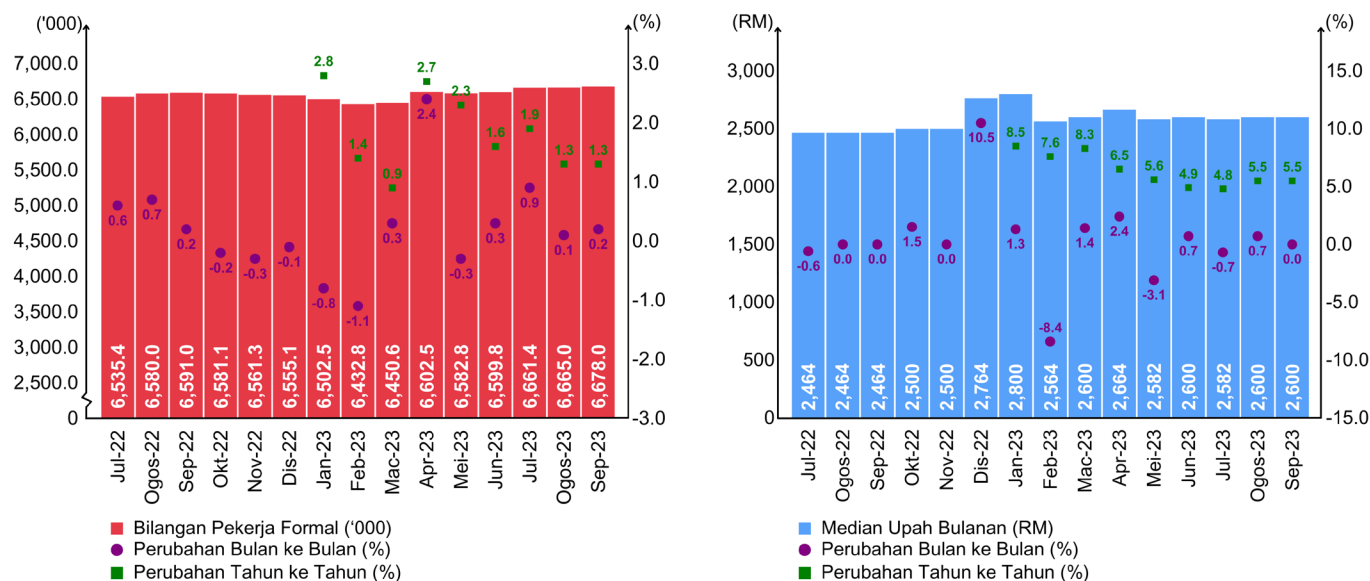

RINGKASAN PENEMUAN

Berdasarkan rekod pentadbiran, bilangan pekerja formal pada September 2023 ialah 6.68 juta orang (Ogos 2023: 6.66 juta orang; Julai 2023: 6.66 juta orang) meningkat sebanyak 1.3 peratus (Ogos 2023: 1.3%; Julai 2023: 1.9%) berbanding dengan bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya. Angka ini membentuk hampir dua pertiga (64.8%) daripada bilangan pekerja bergaji warganegara secara keseluruhan dalam sektor formal. Median upah bulanan bagi pekerja formal warganegara pada September 2023 adalah RM2,600 (Ogos 2023: RM2,600; Julai 2023: RM2,582). (**Carta 1**)

3. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT JANTINA

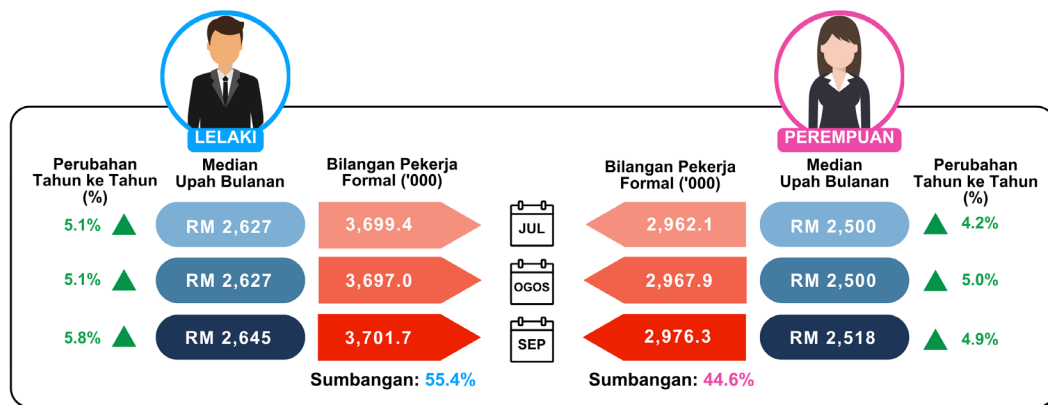
Pada September 2023, pekerja formal lelaki menyumbang lebih daripada separuh jumlah keseluruhan bilangan pekerja formal, merangkumi 55.4 peratus atau bersamaan 3.70 juta orang. Pekerja formal lelaki mencatatkan median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,645 pada September 2023, menunjukkan peningkatan sebanyak 5.8 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya (September 2022: RM2,500). Selain itu, median upah bulanan merekodkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 5.1 peratus untuk kedua-dua bulan Julai dan Ogos 2023.

Sementara itu, pekerja formal perempuan mewakili 44.6 peratus daripada bilangan keseluruhan, dengan jumlah sebanyak 2.98 juta orang (Ogos 2023: 2.97 juta orang; Julai 2023: 2.96 juta orang). Median upah bulanan bagi kumpulan ini pada bulan Julai, Ogos dan September 2023 masing-masing ialah RM2,500, RM2,500 dan RM2,518. Angka ini menunjukkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 4.2 peratus, 5.0 peratus dan 4.9 peratus.

Perbandingan mengikut jantina menunjukkan pekerja formal lelaki secara konsisten memperoleh median upah bulanan yang lebih tinggi berbanding pekerja formal perempuan sepanjang suku tahun ketiga 2023. Median upah bulanan bagi pekerja formal lelaki ialah RM2,645, memperoleh 5.0 peratus lebih tinggi daripada pekerja formal perempuan yang menerima median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,518. Paparan 2: Bilangan Pekerja Formal dan Median Upah Bulanan Mengikut Jantina, Julai - September 2023



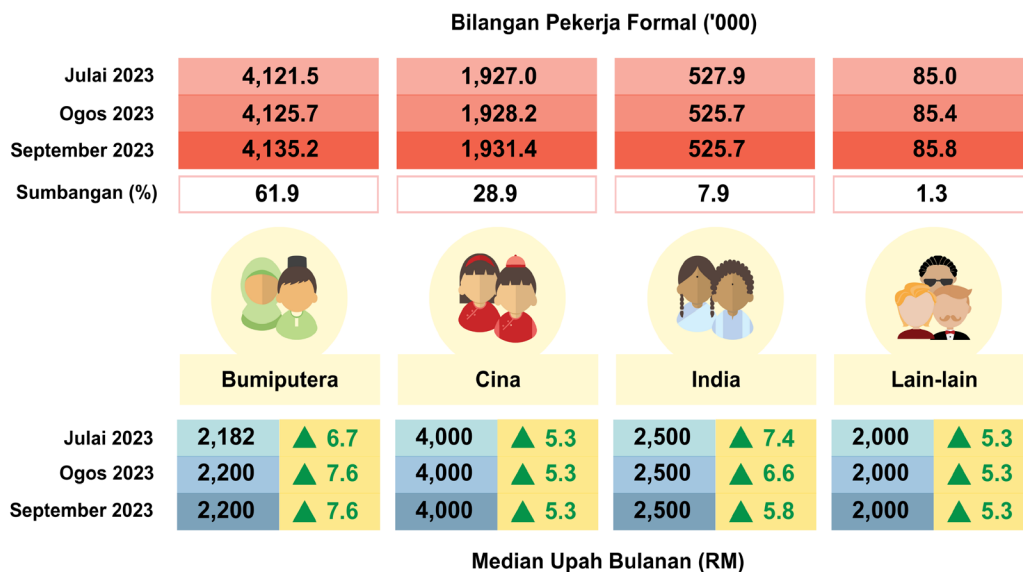

4. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT ETNIK

Median upah bulanan bagi kesemua etnik menunjukkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun bagi ketiga-tiga bulan pada suku tahun ketiga 2023. Pada September 2023, Bumiputera mengalami perubahan tahun ke tahun tertinggi dengan kenaikan sebanyak 7.6 peratus kepada RM2,200 berbanding tahun sebelumnya (September 2022: RM2,045). Peratusan pekerja formal etnik Bumiputera mencapai 61.9 peratus, atau 4.14 juta orang (Ogos 2023: 4.13 juta orang, Julai 2023: 4.12 juta orang).

Pada masa yang sama, pekerja formal Cina, diwakili oleh 28.9 peratus atau bersamaan 1.93 juta orang, menerima median upah bulanan tertinggi sebanyak RM4,000 dengan pertumbuhan 5.3 peratus pada September 2023. Median upah bulanan bagi etnik ini juga kekal tidak berubah selama tiga bulan berturut-turut pada suku tahun ketiga 2023, menyumbang kepada kenaikan 5.3 peratus tahun ke tahun. Selain itu, etnik India, dengan 7.9 peratus atau bersamaan 0.53 juta orang, mencatatkan peningkatan median upah bulanan kepada RM2,500 pada September 2023 (Ogos 2023: RM2,500; Julai 2023: RM2,500), menunjukkan kenaikan 5.8 peratus berbanding tahun sebelumnya (Ogos 2023: 6.6%; Julai 2023: 7.4%). 5. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT KUMPULAN UMUR

Meneliti kumpulan umur, pekerja formal yang berumur 25 hingga 29 memberikan sumbangan yang paling signifikan, merangkumi 19.9 peratus, hampir satu per lima daripada jumlah pekerja formal pada September 2023 (1.33 juta orang). Nisbah ini kekal konsisten dengan angka bagi Ogos 2023 (19.9%) dan Julai 2023 (19.9%). Sementara itu, kumpulan umur 65 tahun dan ke atas memberikan sumbangan paling sedikit, melibatkan hampir 0.10 juta orang, atau 1.5 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja formal.

Membandingkan median upah pekerja bagi September 2023 dengan bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya, semua kumpulan umur mengalami peningkatan median upah bulanan, kecuali bagi mereka yang berumur di bawah 20 tahun. Secara khusus, kumpulan umur 60 hingga 64 tahun menunjukkan peningkatan perubahan tahun ke tahun tertinggi sepanjang setiap bulan pada suku tahun ketiga 2023, mencapai 9.1 peratus. Sebaliknya, mereka yang berumur di bawah 20 tahun tidak mengalami pertumbuhan dengan median upah bulanan tidak berubah dari tahun sebelumnya selama tiga bulan berturut-turut pada suku tahun ketiga 2023.

Tambahan itu, kumpulan umur 45 hingga 49 tahun menerima median upah bulanan tertinggi pada September 2023, iaitu RM3,500. Kumpulan umur ini juga mengekalkan median upah bulanan tertinggi pada Ogos 2023 (RM3,500) dan Julai 2023 (RM3,482). Sebaliknya, kumpulan umur di bawah 20 tahun menerima median upah bulanan terendah sebanyak RM1,500 pada September 2023, kekal tidak berubah sebanyak RM1,500 bagi tiga bulan berturut-turut sepanjang suku tahun ketiga 2023. 6. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT AKTIVITI EKONOMI

Dalam konteks aktiviti ekonomi, median upah bulanan mengalami pertumbuhan positif di semua sektor pada suku tahun ketiga 2023. Secara khusus, sektor Perlombongan & pengkuarian merekodkan median upah bulanan tertinggi sepanjang suku tahun ketiga 2023 (September 2023: RM5,200; Ogos 2023: RM5,200; Julai 2023: RM5,000). Sektor ini mencatatkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun tertinggi pada September 2023 sebanyak 16.5 peratus (Ogos 2023: 15.6%; Julai 2023: 12.0%).

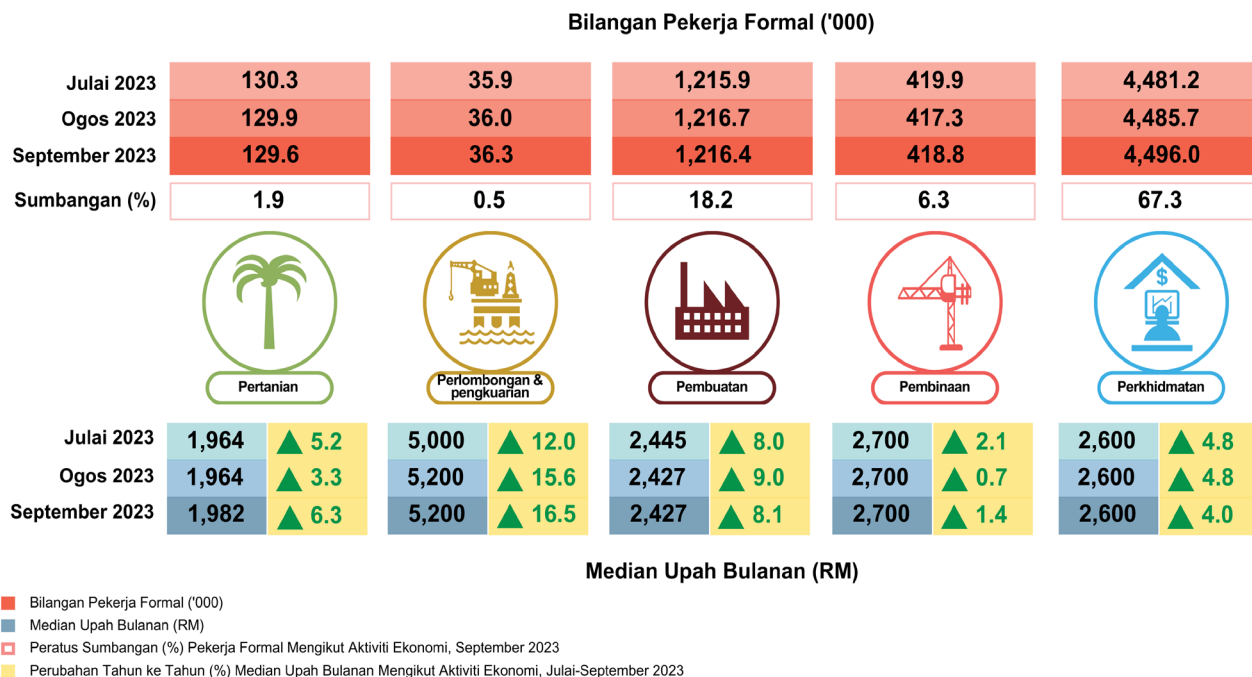
Sementara itu, sektor Perkhidmatan, yang merangkumi jumlah pekerja formal terbesar, menyumbang 67.3 peratus atau bersamaan 4.50 juta orang, mencatatkan kenaikan median upah bulanan sebanyak 4.0 peratus tahun ke tahun kepada RM2,600 pada September 2023 (Ogos 2023: RM2,600; Julai 2023: RM2,600). Subsektor yang mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi pada September 2023 adalah subsektor Kewangan dan insurans iaitu sebanyak RM5,700, diikuti oleh subsektor Maklumat dan komunikasi pada RM4,982. Sebaliknya, subsektor Makanan & minuman dan penginapan mencatatkan median upah bulanan terendah pada RM1,800. Dari segi perubahan tahunan, subsektor Maklumat dan komunikasi mencatatkan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun tertinggi dalam median upah bulanan sebanyak 10.7 peratus kepada RM4,982 pada September 2023 (Ogos 2023: RM4,964; Julai 2023: RM4,964).

Pada masa yang sama, sektor Pembuatan menyumbang sebanyak 1.22 juta orang (sumbangan: 18.2%) daripada jumlah pekerja formal dan merekodkan median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,427 pada September 2023. Ia meningkat sebanyak 8.1 peratus berbanding dengan bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya (Ogos 2023: 9.0%; Julai 2023: 8.0%). Median upah bulanan tertinggi pada September 2023 adalah dalam subsektor Minuman dan produk tembakau (RM3,089), manakala median upah bulanan terendah terdapat dalam subsektor Produk tekstil, pakaian dan kulit (RM1,982).

Sementara itu, dalam sektor Pembinaan, yang merangkumi 6.3 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja formal pada September 2023, memperoleh median upah bulanan sebanyak RM2,700 dengan pertumbuhan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 1.4 peratus. Median upah bulanan kekal tidak berubah untuk ketiga-tiga bulan bagi suku tahun ketiga 2023 (Ogos 2023: 0.7%; Julai 2023: 2.1%). Sektor Pertanian, yang mewakili 1.9 peratus daripada jumlah pekerja formal, mencatatkan median upah bulanan terendah sebanyak RM1,982, menunjukkan peningkatan tahun ke tahun sebanyak 6.3 peratus pada September 2023 (Ogos 2023: RM1,964; Julai 2023: RM1,964). **(Paparan 5)**

7. BILANGAN PEKERJA FORMAL DAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN MENGIKUT NEGERI

Median upah bulanan mengikut negeri bagi suku tahun ketiga 2023, menunjukkan semua negeri mencatatkan pertumbuhan positif tahun ke tahun. Tiga negeri melepasi median upah bulanan nasional sebanyak RM2,600 pada September 2023, dengan W.P. Kuala Lumpur mencatatkan median upah bulanan tertinggi pada RM3,800. Ini diikuti oleh Selangor pada RM2,900 dan Pulau Pinang pada RM2,645 pada September 2023. Walau bagaimanapun, Kelantan, Perlis dan Sabah mencatatkan median upah bulanan terendah dalam tempoh yang sama, dengan masing-masing mencatatkan RM1,600, RM1,627 dan RM1,800.

Merujuk kepada sumbangan bilangan pekerja, tiga negeri utama yang mencatatkan bilangan pekerja formal tertinggi setakat September 2023 disenaraikan mengikut susunan berikut: Selangor (1.89 juta orang; sumbangan: 28.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (1.35 juta orang; sumbangan: 20.2%), dan Johor (0.71 juta orang; sumbangan: 10.6%). (**Paparan 6**)

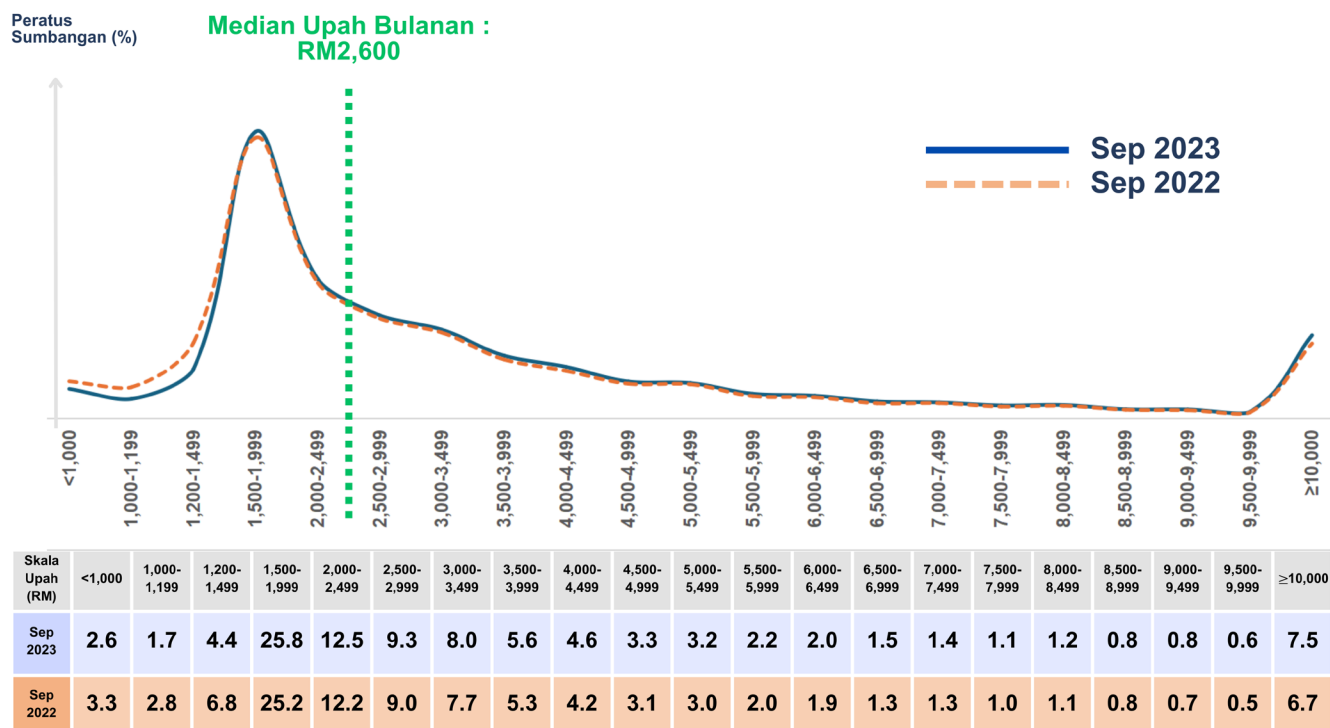

8. TABURAN MEDIAN UPAH BULANAN PEKERJA FORMAL

Analisis taburan upah menunjukkan bahawa 34.6 peratus pekerja formal Malaysia memperoleh pendapatan di bawah RM2,000 pada September 2023. Peratusan ini menandakan penurunan daripada 38.1 peratus yang dicatatkan pada tahun sebelumnya, berkemungkinan kesan daripada kenaikan kadar gaji minimum yang dilaksanakan pada Mei 2022. Pada masa yang sama, hampir 7.5 peratus pekerja formal memperoleh upah bulanan RM10,000 dan ke atas pada September 2023.

Sementara itu, analisis persentil menunjukkan bahawa persentil ke-10 pekerja formal memperoleh upah bersamaan atau kurang daripada RM1,500 sebulan. Walau bagaimanapun, kumpulan ini mengalami peningkatan upah bulanan ketara sebanyak 10.0 peratus berbanding bulan yang sama pada tahun sebelumnya (September 2022: RM1,364). Pada persentil ke-90, pekerja formal di Malaysia memperoleh sekurang-kurangnya RM8,200 sebulan, mencatatkan peningkatan sebanyak 5.1 peratus daripada tahun sebelumnya. Nisbah upah antara kumpulan penerima upah tertinggi (Persentil ke-90) dengan kumpulan penerima upah terendah (Persentil ke-10) menggambarkan bahawa kumpulan penerima upah tertinggi menerima lebih dari lima kali ganda upah berbanding kumpulan penerima upah terendah. **(Carta 2 & Jadual 1)**

9. MENUJU KE HADAPAN

Perantaraan ke hadapan, Jabatan Perangkaan Malaysia (DOSM) beriltizam untuk terus menambah baik data-data ini dalam masa terdekat. Di samping itu, beberapa sumber data lain seperti data emolumen penjawat awam, maklumat pendapatan pembayar cukai, dan set data lain yang berkaitan, sedang dipertimbangkan untuk diliputi agar statistik ini menjadi lebih komprehensif dan inklusif.

Selain itu, melalui pengintegrasian dengan data pentadbiran lain, DOSM akan menghasilkan maklumat yang lebih dinamik merangkumi trend, pola, min, median dan taburan upah mengikut saiz pekerja termasuk statistik mengenai bilangan dan upah pekerja formal mengikut saiz pertubuhan, membezakan antara Perusahaan Kecil dan Sederhana (PKS) dan Perusahaan Mikro, Kecil dan Sederhana (PMKS). Data tersebut juga akan dikategorikan berdasarkan jenis intensif industri (intensif modal atau buruh), mengikut tahap kemahiran dan jenis pekerjaan pekerja, mengikut status syarikat (seperti Syarikat Multi-Nasional - MNC dan Pelaburan Langsung Asing - FDI), mengikut pemilikan pertubuhan syarikat, mengikut perniagaan berorientasikan eksport atau permintaan domestik, mengikut skala ekonomi perniagaan, mengikut usia perniagaan dan lain-lain.

Di samping itu, penambahbaikan daripada aspek metodologi penyusunan dan sumber data baharu dilaksanakan secara berterusan selaras dengan amalan terbaik Pejabat Statistik Negara (NSO) yang lain. Pada masa yang sama, DOSM menjalankan Survei Gaji & Upah yang menggunakan kaedah persampelan dan pendekatan berasaskan isi rumah. Survei ini digunakan sebagai penanda aras bagi gaji dan upah minimum dan median yang diterima oleh penduduk di Malaysia.

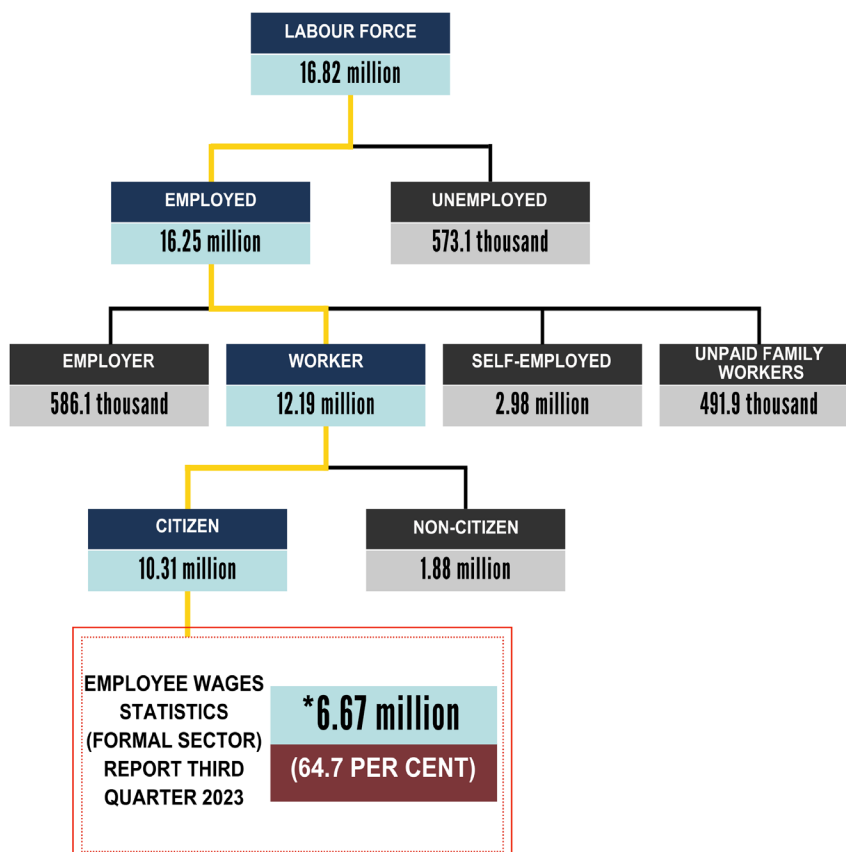
1. INTRODUCTION

The Quarterly Employee Wages Statistics (Formal Sector) Publication is part of the Department of Statistics Malaysia's initiative to provide more comprehensive, granular and frequent wages statistics to meet increasing user demand. This report is based on administrative data from various agencies and primarily focuses on citizen employees in Malaysia's formal private sector. The wages estimated in this publication refers to all monetary payables including bonuses, commissions, and allowances paid to employees for the work done during the reference period. The statistics released can be used as input for analysing the labour market situation, formulating policies, as well as planning, implementing and monitoring programmes related to human resource development towards strengthening Malaysia's labour market.

2. WAGES SITUATION OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES IN MALAYSIA

Malaysia's labour market has exhibited a favourable outlook during the third quarter of 2023 despite amid global economic uncertainties. According to Labour Force Survey Report in the third quarter of 2023, there were 16.25 million employed persons compared to previous quarter (Q2 2023: 16.15 million persons) which consist of paid employees in both public and private sectors, employers, own-account workers and unpaid family workers. Exhibit 1: Monthly Salaries & Wages Analysis Framework, Q3 2023



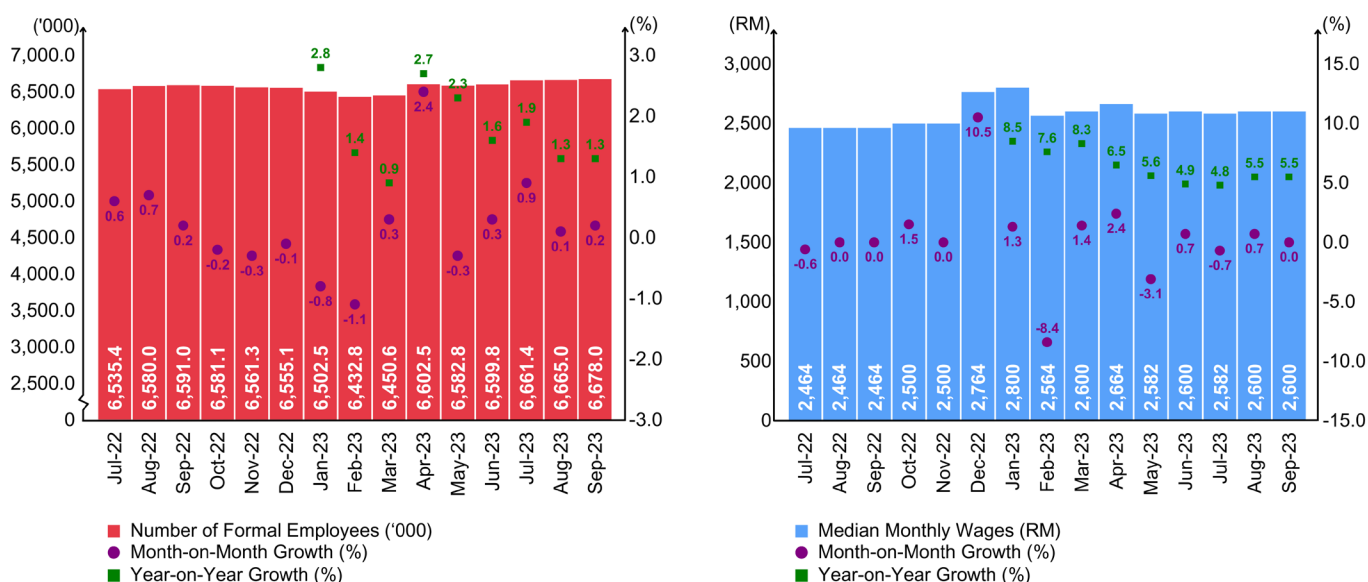

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Based on administrative records, the number of formal employees in September 2023 was 6.68 million persons (August 2023: 6.66 million persons; July 2023: 6.66 million persons) increase by 1.3 per cent (August 2023: 1.3%; July 2023: 1.9%) compared to the same month in the previous year. This figure constituted almost two-third (64.8%) of the total citizen-paid employees in the formal sector. The median monthly wages for citizen formal employees in September 2023 was RM2,600 (August 2023: RM2,600; July 2023: RM2,582). (Chart 1)

3. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY SEX

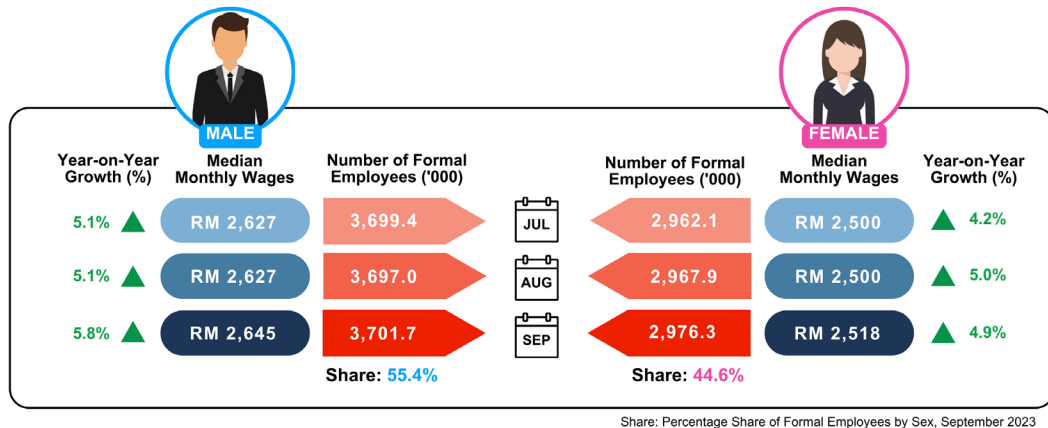
In September 2023, male formal employees accounted for more than half of the total formal employees, constituted 55.4 per cent or equivalent to 3.70 million persons. Male formal employees reported median monthly wages of RM2,645 in September 2023, reflecting an increased by 5.8 per cent compared to the same month in the previous year (September 2022: RM2,500). Moreover, the median monthly wages recorded a year-on-year growth of 5.1 per cent for both July and August 2023.

Meanwhile, female formal employees represented 44.6 percent of the total, amounting to 2.98 million persons (August 2023: 2.97 million persons; July 2023: 2.96 million persons). The median monthly wages for this group in July, August, and September 2023 were RM2,500, RM2,500, and RM2,518, respectively. These figures indicate year-on-year growth of 4.2 per cent, 5.0 per cent, and 4.9 per cent.

Comparison by sex shown that male formal employees consistently earned higher median monthly wages compared to female formal employees throughout the third quarter of 2023. The median monthly wages of male formal employees were RM2,645, earned 5.0 per cent more than female formal employees who received median monthly wages at RM2,518. (Exhibit 2)

4. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY ETHNIC

The median monthly wages of all ethnic groups reported a year-on-year increase over the three months in the third quarter of 2023. In September 2023, Bumiputera experienced the highest year-on-year growth, registering an increase of 7.6 per cent to RM2,200 compared to the preceding year (September 2022: RM2,045). The proportion of formal employees of Bumiputera ethnicity reached 61.9 per cent, or 4.14 million persons (August 2023: 4.13 million persons, July 2023: 4.12 million persons).

At the same time, Chinese formal employees, representing 28.9 per cent or equivalently 1.93 million persons, earned the highest median monthly wages of RM4,000, reflecting a 5.3 per cent growth in September 2023. The median monthly wages for this ethnic remained unchanged for three consecutive months in the third quarter of 2023, constituting to a 5.3 per cent year-on-year growth. Furthermore, the Indian ethnic group, comprising 7.9 per cent or equivalent to 0.53 million persons, witnessed a rise in the median monthly wages to RM2,500 in September 2023 (August 2023: RM2,500; July 2023: RM2,500), indicating 5.8 per cent increase over the previous year (August 2023: 6.6%; July 2023: 7.4%). 5. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY AGE GROUP

Delving into the age groups, formal employees aged 25 to 29 makes the most significant contribution, accounting for 19.9 per cent, nearly one-fifth of the total formal employees in September 2023 (1.33 million persons). This proportion remains consistent with the figures for August 2023 (19.9%) and July 2023 (19.9%). Meanwhile, the age group above 65 years and above generates the least contribution, involving approximately 0.10 million persons, or 1.5 per cent of the total formal employees.

Comparing the median monthly wages for September 2023 to the same month in the previous year, all age groups observed an increase, except for those below 20 years old. Particularly, the age group 60 to 64 years old demonstrated the highest rise year-on-year growth throughout each month of the third quarter of 2023, reaching 9.1 per cent. In contrast, those below 20 years old experienced no growth with the median monthly wages remaining unchanged from the previous year for three successive months in the third quarter of 2023.

Furthermore, the age group of 45 to 49 years old received the highest median monthly wages in September 2023, which is RM3,500. This age group also maintained the highest median monthly wages in August (RM3,500) and July (RM3,482). On the other hand, the age group below 20 years old received the lowest median monthly wages of RM1,500 in September 2023, remaining stagnant at RM1,500 for three consecutive months throughout the third quarter of 2023. 6. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

In terms of economic activity, the median monthly wages witnessed a positive growth across all sectors in the third quarter of 2023. Specifically, the Mining and quarrying sector recorded the highest median monthly wages during the third quarter of 2023 (September 2023: RM5,200; August 2023: RM5,200; July 2023: RM5,000). This sector registered the highest year-on-year growth in September 2023 of 16.5 per cent (August 2023: 15.6%; July 2023: 12.0%).

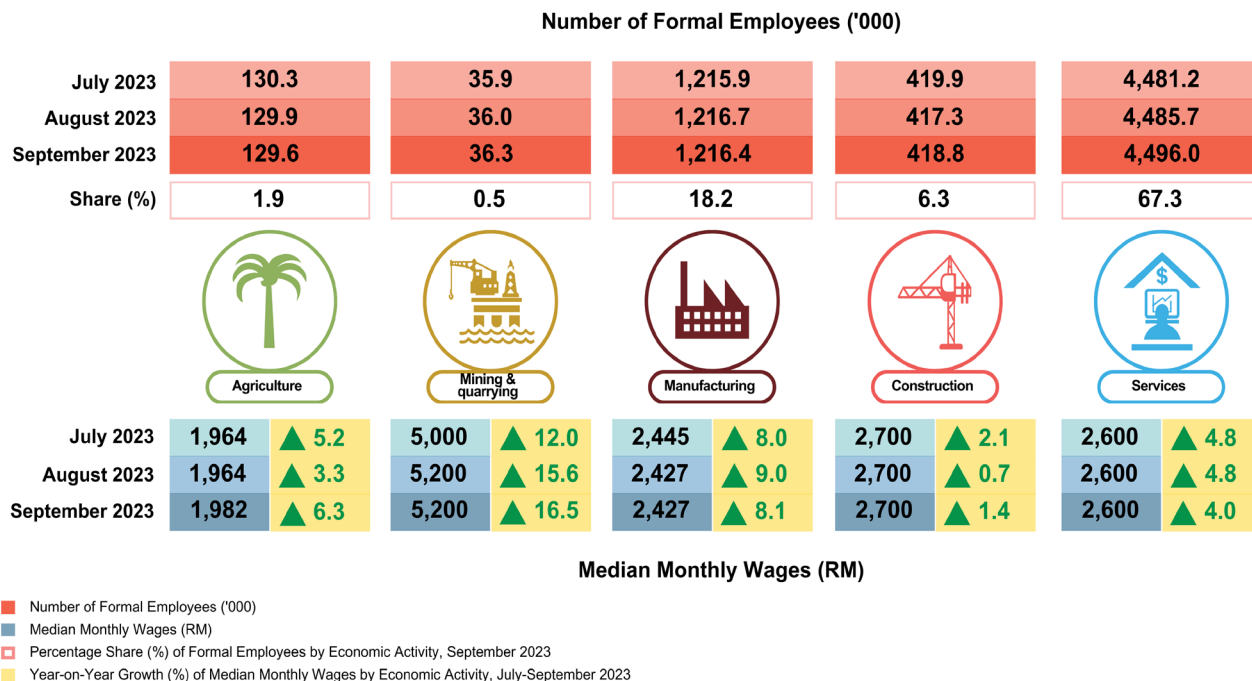
In the meantime, the Services sector, comprising the largest number of formal employees, contributing 67.3 per cent or equivalent to 4.50 million persons, recorded a rise in median monthly wages of 4.0 per cent year-on-year to RM2,600 in September 2023 (August 2023: RM2,600; July 2023: RM2,600). The sub-sector that recorded the highest median monthly wages in September 2023 was Financial and insurance sub-sector at RM5,700, followed by Information and communication at RM4,982. In contrast, the Food & beverages and accommodation sub-sector recorded the lowest median monthly wages at RM1,800. In terms of annual changes, Information and communication sub-sector posted the highest year-on-year growth in median monthly wages of 10.7 per cent to RM4,982 in September 2023 (August 2023: RM4,964; July 2023: RM4,964).

At the same time, the Manufacturing sector contributed 1.22 million persons (share: 18.2%) of the total formal employees and recorded a median monthly wages of RM2,427 in September 2023. It grew by 8.1 per cent compared to same month in the previous year (August 2023: 9.0%; July 2023: 8.0%). The highest median monthly wages in September 2023 were in the Beverage and tobacco products sub-sector (RM3,089), while the lowest median monthly wages were in the Textiles, wearing apparel and leather products sub-sector (RM1,982).

*Meanwhile, the Construction sector, with a composition of 6.3 per cent of the total formal employees in September 2023, earning the median monthly wages at RM2,700 with 1.4 per cent year-on-year growth. The median monthly wages remained constant for all three months for the third quarter of 2023 (August 2023: 0.7%; July 2023: 2.1%). The Agriculture sector, comprising 1.9 per cent of the total formal employees, recorded the lowest median monthly wages of RM1,982, showing a 6.3 per cent year-on-year increase in September 2023 (August 2023: RM1,964; July 2023: RM1,964). 7. NUMBER AND MEDIAN MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES BY STATE

The median monthly wages by state for the third quarter of 2023, showed that all states indicated positive year-on-year growth. Three states surpassed the national median monthly wages of RM2,600 in September 2023, with W.P. Kuala Lumpur recording the highest median monthly wages at RM3,800. This was followed by Selangor at RM2,900 and Pulau Pinang at RM2,645 in September 2023. However, Kelantan, Perlis and Sabah showed the lowest median monthly wages during the same period, each recording figures of RM1,600, RM1,627 and RM1,800 respectively.

Regarding to the contribution of the number of employees, the top three states that posted the highest number of formal employees as of September 2023 were ranked in the following order: Selangor (1.89 million persons; share: 28.3%), W.P. Kuala Lumpur (1.35 million persons; share: 20.2%), and Johor (0.71 million persons; share: 10.6%). (**Exhibit 6**)

8. DISTRIBUTION OF MONTHLY WAGES OF FORMAL EMPLOYEES

Analysis of the wage distribution shows that 34.6 per cent of Malaysian formal employees earned below RM2,000 in September 2023. This proportion marks a decrease from 38.1 per cent recorded in the previous year, possibly attributed to the minimum wage increase implemented in May 2022. Concurrently, approximately 7.5 per cent of formal employees earned monthly wages of RM10,000 and above in September 2023.

*Meanwhile, the percentile analysis indicates that the 10th percentile of formal employees earned wages equal to or less than RM1,500 per month. However, this group experienced a notable monthly wage increase of 10.0 per cent compared to the same month in the previous year (September 2022: RM1,364). At the 90th percentile, formal employees in Malaysia earned at least RM8,200 per month, recorded an increase 5.1 per cent from the previous year. The wage ratio between the highest wage earner group (90th percentile) with the lowest wage earner group (10th percentile) illustrates that the highest wage earner group receive the wage more than five times compared to the lowest wage earner group. Chart 2: Formal Employees Monthly Wages by Wages Scale, September 2022 & September 2023

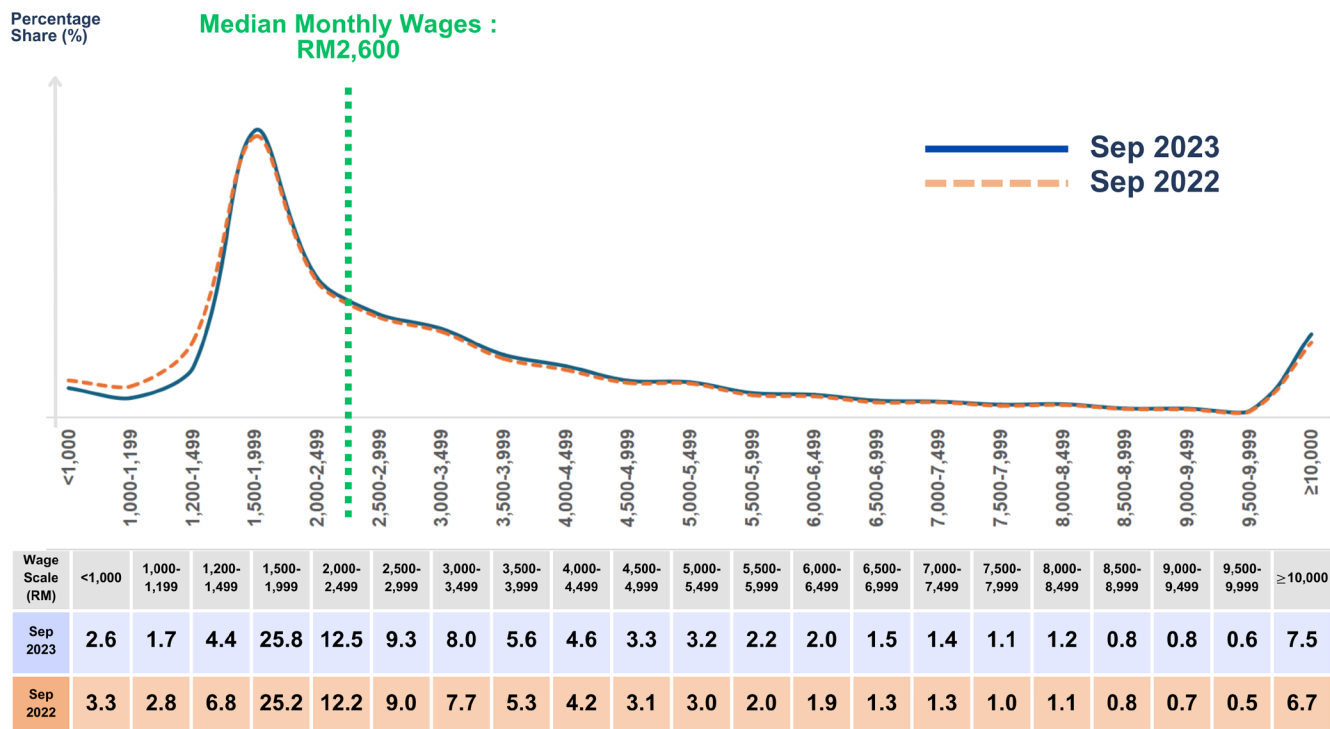

9. MOVING FORWARD

Looking ahead, the Department of Statistics Malaysia (DOSM) is committed to continue to improve these data in the immediate future. In addition, several types of other data sources, such as civil servant emolument data, taxpayer income information, and other relevant datasets, are being considered to be used in order for these statistics to become more comprehensive and inclusive.

Moreover, integrating data from various administrative sources, DOSM will yield dynamic information on trends, patterns, minimum, median, and distribution of employees' wages by size of the employees, including statistics on the number and wages of formal employees categorized by organization size, distinguishing between Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) and Non-Small and Medium Enterprises (Non-SME). The data will also be categorized based on industry intensity (capital-intensive or labor-intensive), skill and occupation levels, company status (such as Multinational Companies - MNCs, Foreign Direct Investment - FDI), company ownership, business orientation (export-oriented or domestic demand-oriented), business economic scale, company establishment period, and other relevant factors.

Besides, the continuous improvement in methodology and the inclusion of new data sources are carried out in line with the practices of other National Statistical Offices (NSOs). Simultaneously, DOSM conducts the Salaries & Wages Survey, which uses sampling methods and household-based approaches. This survey serves as a benchmark for the minimum and median salaries and wages received by the population in Malaysia.

TECHNICAL NOTES

1. PENGENALAN

Statistik Upah Pekerja disusun menggunakan data pentadbiran daripada pelbagai agensi bagi memantau prestasi gaji dan upah negara. Statistik yang dikeluarkan meliputi bilangan pekerja formal dan median upah bulanan. Nota teknikal ini menyediakan penerangan terperinci mengenai konsep, definisi dan metodologi yang digunakan dalam penyusunan statistik ini bagi membantu pengguna untuk lebih memahami berkaitan maklumat upah pekerja yang dikeluarkan.

2. KONSEP DAN DEFINISI

Majikan : Merujuk kepada entiti ekonomi yang bekerja sama ada melalui kontrak perkhidmatan atau latihan perantisan, dan dilaporkan melalui sistem pekerjaan yang sesuai.

Pekerja Formal : Merujuk kepada individu yang bekerja di bawah kontrak perkhidmatan atau latihan perantisan bermajikan dan menerima ganjaran untuk kerja yang diselesaikan. Pekerja formal tidak termasuk mereka yang tergolong di bawah pekerjaan bukan standard, termasuk individu bekerja sendiri, pekerja gig, pekerja akaun sendiri, pekerja keluarga tanpa gaji, dan sebagainya.

Upah : Merujuk kepada semua ganjaran dalam bentuk wang yang dibayar sepanjang tempoh rujukan kepada pekerja. Anggaran upah termasuk bonus, komisen, dan elaun mengikut definisi sumber data. Tidak termasuk caj perkhidmatan; bayaran kerja lebih masa; ganjaran; faedah persaraan; faedah pengurangan pekerja, pemberhentian atau penamatan; mana-mana elaun perjalanan atau nilai mana-mana konsesi perjalanan; atau mana-mana saraan atau bayaran lain sebagaimana yang dikecualikan oleh Menteri.

3. TEMPOH RUJUKAN

Statistik ini berdasarkan kaedah akruan mengikut saranan Sistem Akaun Negara 2008 (SNA), yang mengambil kira bulan ketika kerja dilakukan tanpa mengira bilakah pembayaran dibuat atau diterima.

4. SKOP DAN LIPUTAN

Pengeluaran statistik upah pekerja sektor formal adalah bersumberkan data pentadbiran yang meliputi data caruman wajib simpanan pekerja sektor swasta dan pekerja tidak berpencen di sektor awam serta data caruman insurans keselamatan sosial pekerja yang diperoleh daripada pelbagai agensi dengan tumpuan kepada pekerja warganegara dalam sektor formal di Malaysia. Data ini tidak meliputi orang yang bekerja berada di bawah pekerjaan bukan standard, termasuk pekerja akaun sendiri dan pekerja keluarga yang tidak dibayar.

5. SUMBER DATA

Sumber data utama bagi penerbitan ini adalah daripada beberapa rekod pentadbiran yang dibekalkan oleh agensi berkaitan, seperti Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP), Pertubuhan Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO) dan lain-lain. *Malaysia Statistical Business Register* (MSBR) merupakan kerangka kerja pertubuhan dan perusahaan yang beroperasi di Malaysia turut digunakan sebagai asas penyusunan data. MSBR merangkumi Daftar Syarikat (ROC), Daftar Perniagaan (ROB) dan Perkongsian Liabiliti Terhad (LLP) yang berdaftar dengan Suruhanjaya Syarikat Malaysia (SSM) serta pertubuhan yang berdaftar dengan pihak berkuasa tempatan dan badan profesional.

6. METODOLOGI

Anggaran upah pekerja dalam laporan ini adalah berdasarkan upah dan nilai caruman yang dilaporkan oleh majikan. Oleh kerana data dilaporkan secara tunai (semasa pembayaran dilakukan) dan bukannya asas akruan (masa pembayaran diperoleh), anggaran memerlukan penukaran data daripada asas tunai kepada asas akruan yang dilakukan melalui kaedah "*calendarisation*". Selain itu, untuk menangani sebarang jurang yang berpotensi atau ketidaklengkapan dalam data, kaedah imputasi digunakan.

Bilangan pekerja dikira secara individu, di mana pekerja dengan pelbagai pekerjaan hanya akan dikira sekaligus. Pada masa yang sama, upah bagi individu yang mempunyai pelbagai pekerjaan adalah merujuk kepada jumlah upah yang diperoleh melalui semua pekerjaan yang dilakukan pada bulan rujukan.

Median merujuk kepada nilai yang terletak di tengah-tengah susunan suatu set nombor yang disusun secara tertib. Median upah digunakan untuk memberi gambaran "purata upah" yang lebih tepat kerana penentuan median tidak dipengaruhi nilai ekstrem.

7. PEMBUNDARAN

Hasil tambah bagi sesuatu kategori mungkin berbeza dengan jumlah besar atau sub-jumlah kerana pembundaran.

8. PERINCIAN STATISTIK

Statistik dalam laporan ini diperincikan seperti berikut:

9. SEMAKAN

1. INTRODUCTION

Employee Wages Statistics are compiled using administrative data from various agencies to monitor the performance of national wages and salaries. The statistics released cover the number of formal workers and median monthly wages. This technical note provides a detailed explanation of the concepts, definitions, scope, coverage and methodology used in the compilation of these statistics to help users better understand the wage information released.

2. CONCEPT AND DEFINITION

Employer : Refer to an economic entity with whom the employee has a contract of service or apprenticeship, and is reported through the appropriate employment system.

Formal Employee : Refer to the person who works under a contract of service or apprenticeship with the employer and receives remuneration for the work completed. Formal employees do not include those who fall under non-standard employment, including self-employed, gig-workers, own-account workers, unpaid family workers, etc.

Wages : Refers to all remuneration in money payable made throughout the reference period to employees. The wage estimated includes bonuses, commissions and allowances per the data sources' definition. It does exclude service charges; overtime payments; gratuity; retirement benefits; retrenchment, lay-off or termination benefits; any travelling allowance or the value of any travelling concession; or any other remuneration or payment as may be exempted by the Minister.

Wages do not include income from own businesses or other sources.

Economic Activity : Economic activity is classified according to Malaysian Standard Industrial Classification (MSIC) 2008 which is based on the International Standard Industrial Classification of All Economic Activities (ISIC) Revision 4. The classification of sub-sectors and economic activities is as in exhibit below, with the Manufacturing and Services sectors can be detailed into eight sub-sectors:

Geographical : Geographical location refers to the state where the employer is located. Employer information by state is obtained by integrating data sources with the statistical domain: Malaysia Statistical Business Register (MSBR).

Ethnic : The classification of the Malaysian formal employee's ethnic group is as follows:

- Bumiputera;
- Chinese;
- Indian; and
- Others.

3. REFERENCE PERIOD

The statistics are based on the accrual basis in accordance with the 2008 System of National Accounts (SNA) recommendation, which reflects the month when the work is done regardless of when the payment is made or received.

4. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

The release of these statistics is based on administrative data, including data on the mandatory contribution of retirement savings by the private and non-pensionable public sectors and data on the contribution of social security insurance obtained from various agencies which focus on citizen formal employees in Malaysia. The data does not cover employed persons fall under non-standard employment, including own-account workers and unpaid family workers.

5. DATA SOURCES

The primary data sources for this publication comprise multiple administrative records provided by relevant agencies, i.e., Employees Provident Fund (EPF), Social Security Organisation (SOCSO) and others. Malaysia Statistical Business Register (MBSR), which comprises the list of establishments or enterprises operating in Malaysia gathered from the Register of Companies (ROC), Register of Businesses (ROB) and Limited Liability Partnership (LLP) registered with Companies Commission Malaysia (CCM) as well as establishment that is registered with the local authority and professional bodies also incorporated in the compilation.

6. METHODOLOGY

The estimation of employee wages in this report is based on the wages and value of contributions reported by the employers. As the data are reported on a cash basis (the time when the payment was made) rather than an accrual basis (the time when the payment was earned), the estimates require the conversion of data from a cash basis to an accrual basis done through a “calendarisation” method. Moreover, to address any potential gaps or incompleteness in the data, an imputation method is applied.

The number of employees is calculated on an individual basis, in which the employee with multiple jobs will only be calculated at once. Correspondingly, wage for individual with multiple jobs is refer to the sum of all wages that are earned through all jobs performed in the reference month.

The median refers to the middle observation in a set of data that are arranged in a sequence. The median wage is used to give a more accurate picture of the “average wage”, as the determination of the median is not affected by extreme values.

7. ROUNDING

Due to rounding, the sum of component figures may not tally with the sub-total or total statistics.

8. DETAIL OF STATISTICS

The statistics in this report are presented as follows:

- i. Sex;
- ii. Ethnic;
- iii. Age group;
- iv. Economic activity;
- v. State.

9. REVISION

Data that underlying these estimates are subjected to revision which relates to receiving additional or more complete data over time, particularly the contribution value of which used in estimating the wage values.

10. PRIVACY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

Legislative requirements stated in Statistics Act 1965 [Act 415] and Personal Data Protection Act 2010 [Act 709] to ensure the privacy and secrecy of this data have been followed. Furthermore, in accordance with the Census Act 1960 [Act 16], the results have been confidential to ensure that they are not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation.
