Malaysia's Industrial Production Index (IPI) remained positive in the final month of 2021 with a growth of 5.8 per cent

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) increased **5.8 per cent** in December 2021 as compared to the same month of the previous year. The expansion of IPI was contributed by the increment of **8.4 per cent** in Manufacturing index and **3.7 per cent** in Electricity index. Meanwhile, Mining Index recorded a decline of **2.5 per cent**.

The Manufacturing sector output based on year-on-year comparison increased by **8.4 per cent** in December 2021 after recording a growth of 11.3 per cent in November 2021. The main subsectors

contributed to the growth in Manufacturing sector in December 2021 were Electrical & Electronics Products (**18.2%**), Food, Beverages & Tobacco Products (**10.3%**) and Non-metallic Mineral Products, Basic Metal & Fabricated Metal Products (**5.3%**). Simultaneously, export-oriented and domestic-oriented industries recorded a growth of **9.6 per cent** and **5.7 per cent** respectively.

The Mining sector output declined **2.5 per cent** in December 2021 as compared to the same period of the previous year. The deterioration was affected by the decrease in Crude Oil & Condensate index (**-5.5%**) and Natural Gas index (**-0.2%**). The Electricity sector output rose **3.7 per cent** in December 2021 as compared to the same month last year.

The IPI for the fourth quarter 2021 grew **6.9 per cent** as compared to the same period of the previous year. The increase was attributed by the growth in Manufacturing index (**9.2%**) and Electricity index (**4.3%**). Meanwhile, Mining index contracted **0.8 per cent**.
