
INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA MAY 2017



Malaysia's Index of Industrial Production (IPI) increased by 4.6% in May 2017

The Index of Industrial Production (IPI) increased by **4.6%** in May 2017 as compared to the same month of the previous year supported by the strong growth in Manufacturing index **(7.3%)** and Electricity index **(2.5%)**. However, the Mining index declined by **2.3%**.

The Manufacturing sector output continued to record a significant growth of **7.3%** in May 2017 after an expansion of **6.7%** recorded in April 2017. The major sub-sectors which expanded in May 2017 were: Electrical and Electronics Products **(11.6%)**; Food, Beverages and Tobacco **(12.9%)**; and Petroleum,

Chemical, Rubber and Plastic Products (3.1%).

The Mining sector output contracted by **2.3**% in May 2017 (April 2017 : **-2.0**%) due to the decrease of **5.4**% in Crude Oil index. Meanwhile, Natural Gas index rose **1.5**%.

The Electricity sector output increased by **2.5%** in May 2017 after a decrease of **1.5%** recorded in April 2017.
