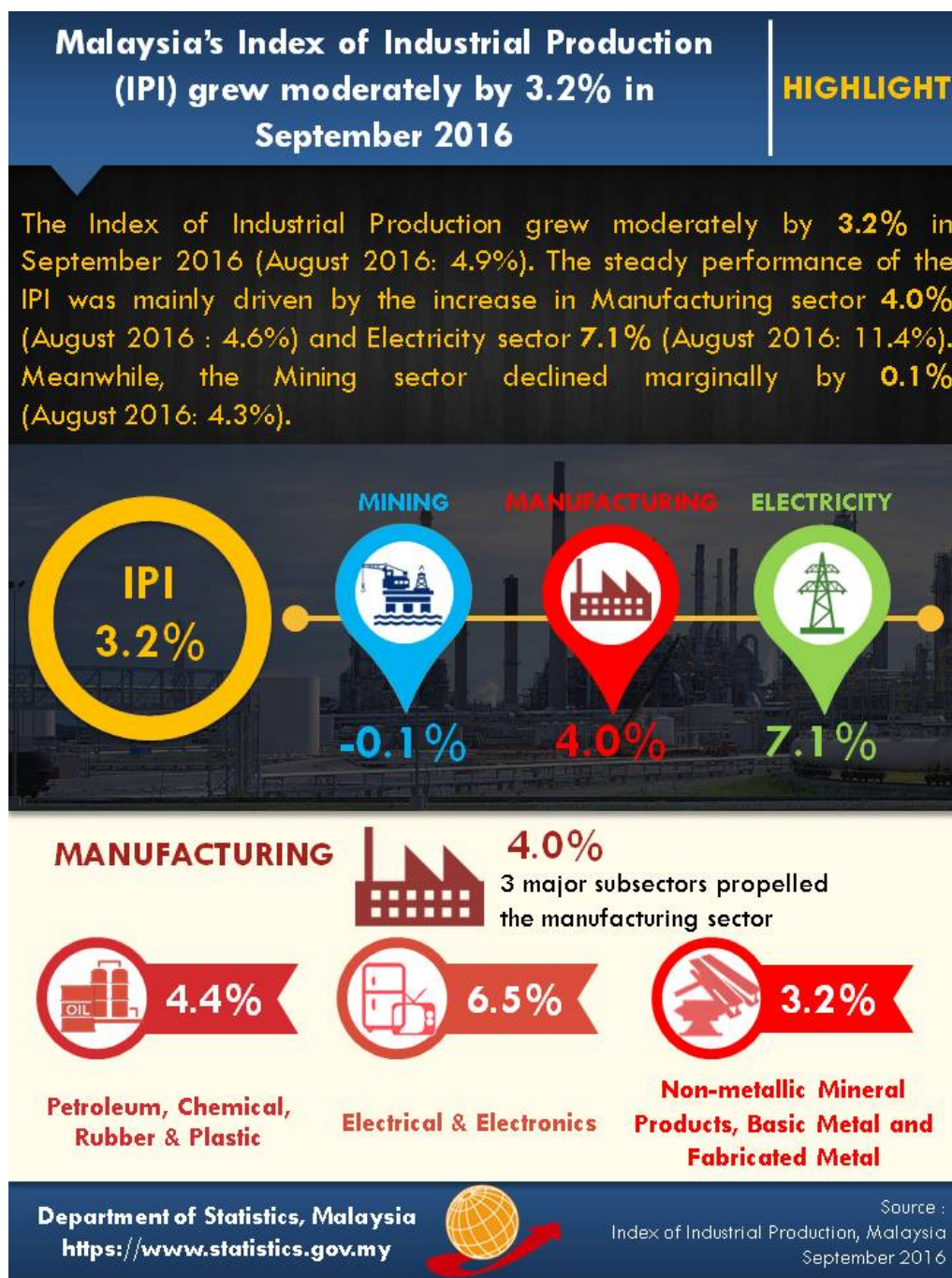




INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, MALAYSIA SEPTEMBER 2016



Malaysia's Index of Industrial Production (IPI) grew moderately by 3.2% in September 2016

The Index of Industrial Production (IPI) grew moderately by **3.2%** in September 2016 as compared to the same month of the previous year. The steady performance of the IPI in September 2016 was mainly driven by the increase in Manufacturing sector (**4.0%**) and Electricity sector (**7.1%**). Meanwhile, the Mining sector declined marginally by **0.1%**

Manufacturing sector increased moderately by **4.0%** in September 2016 after registering 4.6% increase in August 2016. The major sub-sectors which expanded in September 2016 were: Petroleum, Chemical, Rubber and Plastic Products (**4.4%**); Electrical and Electronics Products (**6.5%**) and Non-metallic Mineral Products, Basic Metal and Fabricated Metal Products (**3.2%**).

The Mining sector output contracted by **0.1%** in September 2016 (August 2016 : 4.3%) due to the **2.3%** decrease in Crude Oil index. The Natural Gas index however rose **2.6%**.

The Electricity sector output increased by **7.1%** in September 2016 after registering a growth of 11.4% in August 2016.
